Day 1: Monday, September 18, 2023

We depart this morning, making appropriate rest stops en route. A lunch stop will be made on our own at **Salt City Market**- a food hall and public market to show off hidden culinary gems of Syracuse offering regional and international cuisines from talented and driven entrepreneurs.

Then, **Tibbets Lighthouse and Museum**. Standing guard at confluence of St. Lawrence River and Lake Ontario, this lighthouse has stood vigil since 1827. Features the only original working Fresnel lens in Lake Ontario. Listen to the forlorn cry of the last operating fog horn on the river. Scenery is spectacular. Upon arrival to Alexandria Bay, we will check into Thompspon's Resort. Located on the Seaway and in the heart of Alexandria Bay, you'll have the ideal location to explore this area. Each room has a balcony. Dinner tonight is next door at **Riley's by the River** – the upbeat casual atmosphere and delicious menu mirror the personality of this town!

Day 2: Tuesday, September 19, 2023

Enjoy breakfast at Riley's by the River

Meet the local guide for a full day tour

Two Nations Tour takes a 22-mile journey through the international waters of America and Canada, giving you the best view of this truly unique geographical area shared by two nations, and you don't even need a passport! This international tour offers close-up enjoyment of historic and scenic wonders in both the American and Canadian sections of the 1000 Islands.

Then visit to **Boldt Castle**. This 120-room Rhineland-style castle and yacht house was built at the turn of the 20th century. The millionaire proprietor of the famous Waldorf Astoria in NYC, George Boldt, built the castle as a display of his love for his wife. Wander the halls and imagine what could have been if tragedy had not struck.

Enjoy a boxed lunch aboard the cruise.

Professional guides will share the colorful history of the magnificent homes built during the gilded age as well as biographical information about their owners, point out landmarks such as Devils Oven, Sunken Rock Lighthouse, the Canadian Span of the 1000 Islands Bridge System, and Tom Thumb Island, detail historic events that took place during the War of 1812 and much, much more.

The **Antique Boat Museum** is the premiere freshwater boating museum in America. A tour here illuminates the exciting history of the region as your docents tell personal stories. Today you will also enjoy a tour on La Duchess - Built in 1903 for hotelier George Boldt, manager of New York City's famed Waldorf-Astoria hotel, the houseboat has been in continuous use as an elegant summer residence ever since. Luxurious and opulent!

Day 3: Wednesday, September 20, 2023

Enjoy breakfast at Riley's by the River

Meet your guide in the lobby of your hotel. Depart for Massena (by coach) passing the lovely pastoral scenery along the seaway.

Arrive at the **Eisenhower Locks**. The Seaway Visitors' Center at the Eisenhower Lock provides tourists and ship watchers with an observation deck where they can view commercial vessels and cruise ships from around the world as they transit the lock. The top deck is open to the public, and guides are available to provide additional information to tourists. Hundreds of ships from all over the world make thousands of transits through the St. Lawrence Seaway annually. They carry a wide variety of cargoes including grains, iron ore, coal, steel, stone, steel slabs, and project cargoes such as windmill components.

Lunch on own at Busters in Ogdensburg

Frederick Remington Art Museum— This was the home of Frederic Remington, an American painter, illustrator, sculptor, and writer who specialized in depictions of the Old American West. This museum houses a comprehensive collection of original Remington paintings, sketches and sculptures, as well as a broad array of personal effects and correspondence that serve to bring the artist and his vision to life.

After, stop at a local winery to enjoy the delicious wines this region creates!

Dinner tonight is at Cavallario's Steak and Seafood – a local favorite! It features American cuisine with an Italian flair behind a castle-style exterior.

Day 4: Thursday, September 21, 2023

Enjoy breakfast at Riley’s by the River

Check out and depart for home.

On the way home stop at **The National Baseball Hall of Fame**, in Cooperstown NY. The Museum tells visitors the story of baseball through its three-story timeline, with the majestic Plaque Gallery serving as a centerpiece. You’ll enjoy a tour of this museum.
