Our first visit of the day is to the **Dickinson Plantation**, home of one of the founding fathers of the United States, signer of the U.S. Constitution, and "Penman of the Revolution." Here, we will enjoy a guided tour and learn about the plantation’s close ties to the Underground Railroad.

We end the day by heading north on the path of freedom to Dover, the Capital City of the First State and visiting the **First State Heritage Park**, the urban “park without boundaries.” Our visit includes a stop at the Old State House, Delaware’s first permanent capital building, for a captivating interpretation of Delaware’s Underground Railroad connection and courageous heroes. We will also enjoy a tour of the John Bell House dating back to the midpoint of the 18th century, it represents a lovely example of early Chesapeake and Delaware architecture and is the oldest wooden-frame structure in Dover.
