# "Long Island!"

### Day One: Monday, October 14, 2024:

We make our way to *Long Island*, *NY*, making appropriate rest / comfort and lunch on own stops enroute.

Long Island, New York, located in the Atlantic Ocean, is culturally and ethnically diverse, featuring some of the wealthiest and most expensive neighborhoods in the world near the shorelines, as well as working-class areas in all four counties. We visit *Westbury Gardens* – listed on the National Registry of Historic Places, the former home of John S. Phipps. The magnificent Charles II-style mansion is nestled amid 200 acres of formal gardens, landscaped grounds, woodlands, ponds and lakes. Westbury House is furnished with fine English antiques and decorative arts from more than fifty years of the family's residence. We check into our hotel, *The Hampton Inn Huntington. Dinner is included* this evening at a nearby restaurant.



After your *included breakfast* at the hotel, meet your *Local Guide* for a full day of visits. First stop is the *Long Island Museum of American Art, History and Carriages* – this museum began toward the end of the Great Depression and has continued to grow with art and artifacts and eventually adding a carriage collection. It has grown to become a leading cultural institution on Long Island and the only Smithsonian Affiliate in the region. *Lunch is included*, nearby. Next, we visit *Walt Whitman Farmhouse and Birthplace* – this restored farmhouse is the birthplace of America's greatest poet – Walt Whitman, built by his father, and listed on the National Register of Historic Places and features period furnishings. *Dinner is included* this evening.

#### Day Three: Wednesday, October 16, 2024:

After your *included breakfast* at the hotel, meet your *Local Guide* for another full day of touring. First, we visit the *Vanderbilt Museum, Mansion and Planetarium* – located in Centerport, this is the estate of William K. Vanderbilt II. He loved the oceans and the natural world, and in his seagoing global travels, he collected fish and other marine life, birds, invertebrates and cultural artifacts for the personal museum he planned to build on his estate. Your admission includes access to the Mansion (including the Habitat and Stoll Wing animal dioramas, and natural-history and cultural-artifact galleries in the Memorial Wing), the Hall of Fishes marine museum, Planetarium exhibits, and the grounds and gardens. You will enjoy a *picnic lunch* at the museum, before your visit to the *Reichert Planetarium*, which











is the most technologically advanced theatre of its kind on Long Island. The theatre's hybrid system can show an incredibly realistic starry sky to lift audiences off Earth and have them travel anywhere in the known universe! After, you will visit *Eagle's Nest* – the summer home of William K. Vanderbilt II, the great-grandson of Cornelius Vanderbilt, also listed on the National Register of Historic Places, it was built initially in 1910 as a small English cottage. Over the next 30 years, the house grew into the sprawling 24-room Spanish-Revival mansion you will see today. *Dinner is included* this evening.



## Day Four: Thursday, October 17, 2024:

After your *included breakfast* at the hotel, meet your *Local Guide* for a morning tour beginning at *Sagamore Hill* – which was the home of the 26<sup>th</sup> President of the United State, Theodore Roosevelt until his death. It is known as his "Summer Whitehouse." You will explore 83-acres of natural surroundings, historic buildings, and trails to become inspired by the legacy of one of America's most popular presidents. *Lunch is included* before we depart for home, making appropriate rest/comfort and dinner on own stops.
