PAYMENT INFORMATION: A NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of \$350 per person is due along with the reservation coupon in order to confirm your land and air reservation. Final payment and full legal names of all persons traveling are due on or before FRIDAY, JUNE 19, 2020. If final payment is NOT received by deadline date, reservation will be automatically cancelled and deposit will be forfeited. No extensions or exceptions will be permitted.
