The Rotary Club of Big Canoe 2025 Scholarship Application Requirements

The Rotary Club of Big Canoe announces the availability of scholarship funds to selected high school seniors in the graduating class of 2025. Recipient selection will be based on personal integrity, academic achievement, financial need, individual characteristics, service to others and demonstrating good citizenship without regard to race, religion, gender and national origin. Extracurricular activities and future goals are also taken into consideration. For the 2025 Rotary Club of Big Canoe Scholarships, we will allocate money specifically for those attending college or university <u>AND</u> to students attending vocational or technical schools.

Who may apply for a Rotary Club of Big Canoe Scholarship? Any student who:

- Is a US legal resident of the United States and attends a high school in Pickens and or Dawson County, and
- 2) Is graduating from an accredited high school or home school program, and
- 3) Wishes to further his/her education as a full-time student in a college, university or vocational/technical college.
- 4) Is pursuing a STEAM related career (includes one in science, technology, engineering, math & the arts).

To be considered for a Rotary Club of Big Canoe Scholarship, students must do the following:

- 1) Complete a Rotary Club of Big Canoe application form obtainable at the Counselor's Office and on the Rotary Club of Big Canoe website.
- 2) To be considered for one of the <u>college/university scholarships</u>, the student **must provide** the Scholarship Committee with an official transcript of high school grades for grades 9-12 and ACT / SAT scores. Applicants must be HOPE qualified, with a <u>3.25 GPA in core courses</u>. Please list any AP or Dual Enrollment Credits as well.
- 3) To be considered for one of the <u>vocational-technical scholarships</u>, the student **must provide** the Scholarship Committee with an official transcript of high school grades for grades 9-12. Applicants should have earned an overall high school GPA of 2.5 or greater. Please list any Dual Enrollment Credits as well. Note, if you are applying for the vocational/technical scholarship, <u>you must</u> answer Optional Essay #4 in the Personal Response Section of the Application.
- 4) All applicants MUST provide two written personal references: one from the school, such as a teacher, counselor, or administrator; and one from an adult outside the school or family (one you who have worked for or volunteered with for example).
- 5) All applicants should complete the Senior Profile. A school counselor will provide the necessary information to secure and complete the form. The completed form must be typed or neatly written and legible. Please be as specific as possible in responding to the questions.
- 6) Please provide a letter of acceptance (if possible) from the college(s), university(s) or technical college(s) of the student's choice in the application.
- 7) Provide a Senior Resume from grades 9th through 12th grades. Include community service involvement.
- 8) Each qualified applicant for an award must be a current-year graduate of high school, enroll in an accredited college or university or technical school, and undertake at least twelve (12) semester hours, or considered a full-time student during each semester or quarter the award benefit is received.
- 9) Include a copy of your current class schedule.

NOTE:

- 1) Completed applications should be submitted to your counselor (Ms. Champion/PCHS, Dr. Higgins/DCHS or Mr. Hites/MLA) by the end of day no later than **FRIDAY**, **JANUARY 24**, **2025**. A representative from the Rotary Club of Big Canoe will then pick up the applications the following week. You can also mail your application directly to Kathy Ebener: Scholarship Chairperson, The Rotary Club of Big Canoe, 11937 Big Canoe, Jasper, GA 30143-5152. If you elect to do this, the application must be postmarked by Friday, January 24, 2025. (Electronic and late applications will not be accepted.)
- 2) Funds are awarded to the student but payable to the university, college or technical school of the student's choice. The Rotary Club of Big Canoe plans to award seven \$10000 scholarships (including 5 to students attending college/university and 2 to students who plan to enroll in vocational/technical school).
- 3) Students will be interviewed at their respective schools after the application is due. The interview process is part of the application process and counts 25% of the total points to be earned for the scholarship award. Interviews are scheduled for February 2025 at the respective schools. Note: Interviewers will have access to the information in the student application file.
