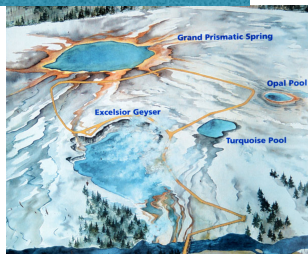


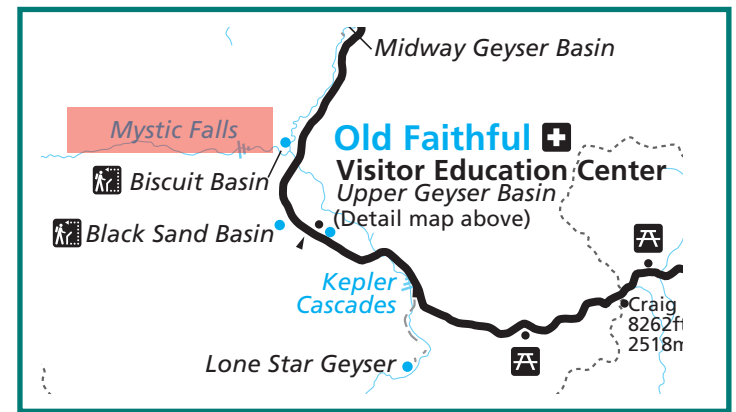


- When you exit this drive, turn **Left** (south) toward Old Faithful.
- About **3.25 miles** you'll come to **Midway Geyser Basin**.
- This is a spectacular stop, featuring **Grand Prismatic Spring** (the grandest and most picturesque spring, with an easy hiking trail).
- Park in the parking lot and walk along the boardwalks around the geyser and other springs.
- **BETTER YET**: skip this exit and go a little farther up to the Fairy Falls Parking Area. Take the wide, gravel trail across the bridge to the Grand Prismatic Overlook trail. You will find a great place to take professional pictures of the Grand Prismatic Spring!
- Plan on **1.5 hours** at this stop.

- About **2.5 miles** further south, you'll come to **Biscuit Basin**. If you're short on time, this could be missed without too much regret.
- If you like to hike, there is a great trail to **Mystic Falls** at the back of the loop around these pools.
- It's a **3.5 mile** loop but the trail is fairly easy, with a few ups and downs near the end, where you'll get to see a 70 foot waterfall in a small canyon.
- Allow **1.5 to 2 hours** for hiking the trail, **15-30 minutes** if you just take the loop around the springs.
