# Tour I

## West Thumb, Yellowstone Lake



- From Old Faithful, go **South** toward **West Thumb**. If you are coming from **Biscuit Basin**, go south past Old Faithful (don't exit).
- A couple miles from there you can make a quick stop at Kepler Cascades. This is
  a short 5 to 15 minute stop to see some pretty cascading waterfalls, just off the
  side of the road.
- There is an extra stop here, if you are interested. We found it very interesting and loved it! It is the Lone Star Geyser. Park in the parking area just past Kepler Cascades. It is a 2.5 mile, out and back trail that was once a paved road. This is one of the few trails you can ride a bicycle on in the park. (We suggest that over walking). Lone Star is an interesting geyser that is worth the effort of getting out to and watching. It has 2 eruptions; one that is shorter in height and length of time and a second one about 20-25 minutes later that goes at least 40 feet in the air and erupts for 25-45 minutes.
- Continue your journey to West Thumb, about 15 miles over the Craig Pass.
- There you can take a .5 mile/15 minute walk around the boardwalk to see Fishing Cone and view Yellowstone Lake close-up.
- Visit the Grant Village Visitor Center for park info, tours and a gift shop.



By this point, you will want to head to your overnight destination (or back to Rexburg).

# Route I:

- From West Thumb and Grant Village head to the South Entrance.
- Head through John D. Rockefeller Park to the North Entrance of Grand Teton National Park, 28 miles.
- From that point there are 2 routes you can take, both will get you to Jackson, Wyoming. The first one takes you past Jenny Lake, if you want to go that way.

#### Choice A

- After entering Grand Teton National Park, stay on Hwy 191 for 16 miles to Jackson Lake Junction.
- Turn Right onto Teton Park Road (the blue route)
- Go 20 miles past Jenny Lake to Moose Entrance.
- Go Left then Right onto Hwy 191 at Moose Junction.
- Go 12 miles to Jackson.



### Choice B

- After entering Grand Teton National Park, stay on Hwy 191 for 16 miles to Jackson Lake Junction.
- Turn Left on Hwy 191 (the red route)
- Go 5 miles to Moran Junction and turn Right
- Go 18 miles to Moose Junction
- Go 12 miles to Jackson.
- From Jackson, Wyoming (via Driggs, Idaho) it is 81 miles to Rexburg.
- Total mileage: **I57-I60 miles**
