

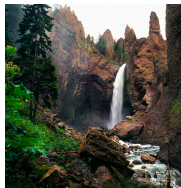
North:
Dunraven Pass to Tower-
Roosevelt, Lamar Valley

South:
Hayden Valley, Yellowstone
Lake, Lake Village

Head north on Grand Loop Road for 1.3 miles to the **Cascade Lake Trailhead**. There you can hike the 4.4 moderate, out and back trail.

A few more miles up is the **Mount Washburn Trailhead** at the peak of the Dunraven Pass.

About 10 miles further you will reach **Tower Falls**.



Just 2.5 miles farther up the road you will come to **Roosevelt Lodge/Tower Junction**. If you take the Northeast Entrance Road through the **Lamar Valley**, you will have a really good chance to see bison and possibly even bear if the season is cooler.

From **Tower Junction**, head west to **Mammoth Hot Springs** (19 miles).

After a tour of the terraces, top and bottom, take a quick trip north (5 miles) to **Gardiner** where you can take a selfie at **Roosevelt Arch** and tour the small town of Gardiner where there are places to eat and shop.

Heading home: to get back to Rexburg, go south from Mammoth to Madison Junction (34 miles) and west through West Yellowstone on Hwy 20 (82 miles).

Head down Grand Loop Road, Fishing Bridge - Canyon Rd through the **Hayden Valley** toward **LeHardy's Rapids**.



There is a picnic area with picnic tables and some quick trails along the river. There are usually some good sightings of large animals (elk, bison, bear) through here when they are out. Before you get to LeHardy's Rapids there are some great stops at **Mud Volcano**, **Dragon's Mouth Geyser** and **Sour Lake** (all at the asme stop) with other sites as well.

You can continue south on this road to **Lake Village** (6 miles), **Bridge Bay** (3 miles) and **West Thumb** (18 miles).

From there, head north again to **Madison** (past Old Faithful) and out through **West Yellowstone**

Tour 3

West Yellowstone, Madison, Norris,
Mammoth, Tower-Roosevelt, Canyon

- Beginning at **West Yellowstone, Montana**.
- Enter the Park at the **West Entrance**.
- Follow the Madison River to **Madison Junction, 14 miles**.
- Turn **Left** at the junction.
- It is another **14 miles** to **Norris**.
- There is a museum and information station there. Find parking and explore this geyser basin. The world's tallest geyser (400 feet) is here, not at Old Faithful. Grab a trail map and explore some great places around this area!
- You could spend anywhere from **30 min to 2 hours** here.
