



The ensuing adventure with its unforeseen events and unusual acquaintances, sometimes bordering on the bizarre, proves enlightening, if not life changing, for both of them.

Although originally drafted in 2004 and 2005, the adventure was not completely published for twenty years, in May 2025, which may be an auspicious time to let us know that things could always be worse.

Tom strikes a nerve when he proposes a local trip to Harry. What follows is an epic historic-hysteric journey.






































Day 2 - Strange Trip to Pine Island

















Day 3 - Into the Woods

The Corps of Discovery plunges into the piney woods only to find that reaching the summit is truly an uphill struggle.











Our intrepid band literally delves into the secret of Pine Island, but can they reemerge?





















































The next morning, our crew sets sail for further adventure, again not knowing where night will find them.




















































Day 6 - Pig in the City

After an overnight stay with the sewer rats, Tom and Harry continue their explorations, this time footloose in an urban setting.
































































Day 7 - The League of Extraordinary Animals -orMutiny on the Leaky

What started out as a random adventure becomes a critical mission to save Gozaimasu, the lake, and all the area residents.


























Tom and Harry find themselves in Gozaimasu, but there is no time to visit the Tastee Diner or take in a movie at the 1-1/2 Cinema Complex.







































Day 9 - Working the Grid

Admittedly, our plot has spiraled out of control, but what made you think it was ever planned out in advance?







Finally, we can anticipate some resolution. If you're offended by all this, you may demand some restitution, but how much did it cost you in the first place?



















