Wrestlers Code of Conduct

1. No wrestler is to abuse any coach or fellow wrestler physically or verbally.
2. Wrestlers must listen to and follow the directions of all coaches and helpers. Wrestlers will be expected to work hard at practice or will be asked to sit. Wrestlers are not to be disruptive during practice or competitions.
3. Wrestlers are expected to participate in practice.
4. If a wrestler is disruptive during practice:
 - a. In the first occurrence, the wrestler will be asked to sit out of practice.
 - b. Second occurrence, parents will receive an email about the issue.
 - c. Third occurrence may result in dismissal from the team.
5. At all times, wrestlers must conduct themselves in a respective manner. You are representing the club.
6. No wrestler is to use abusive an/or profane language during a Wahoo Wrestling Club function. (This includes practices, tournaments, meetings, etc.)
7. All wrestlers are to treat the Wahoo property and equipment with respect.
8. All wrestlers should cheer on each other and support other wrestlers on the team.

Parents Code of Conduct

1. No parent is to abuse another parent, fan, coach, wrestler or referee physically or verbally. If there is an issue the proper avenue is to discuss it with a Wahoo Wrestling Club board member in private at an appropriate time.
2. All parents are to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner.
3. Except in an emergency, no parent is to interfere with practices, meets or coaching at any time.
4. All parents are to observe from the designated spectator locations unless to take a photo/video and do not interfere with coaching when a coach is present.
5. If you prefer to coach your wrestler at tournaments, please let us know and the coaches will coach another wrestler. If you are on the mat coaching, we assume you do not need a club coach to assist. Gold season wrestlers should not have parents at the mat unless they are the coach.
