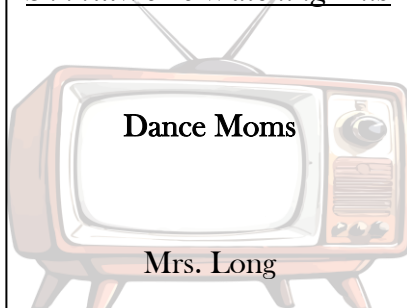
Gracie Hughes-Mier

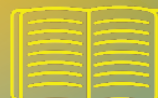

Meet Oranges, a once-feral feline who has gone from surviving on the streets to soaking up the comforts of home life!

Oranges first arrived at the Shelbyville Shelter as a stray who wanted absolutely nothing to do with people. He was wild, wary, and uninterested in domestication. The shelter staff faced a difficult decision—either euthanize him or give him a chance at freedom. Their compassion won out, and they left a window open during cleaning, allowing Oranges to “escape.”

To everyone’s surprise, he didn’t go far. Each morning, Oranges returned alongside another cat the staff affectionately named Ratchet, waiting patiently for breakfast. For the next four years, the pair faithfully showed up, and the shelter team continued to feed and watch over them. When Brooke and the current team arrived, they continued the daily ritual—and slowly, Oranges began to trust again.

Eventually, he allowed gentle pets, then full affection. The team was able to safely trap him and bring him in for Surgery Term, where he was neutered, had a dental cleaning, and even had several teeth extracted.

Today, this once-feral tomcat is living his best life with Allison Rees, a July graduate of Vet Tech Institute of Indiana. From avoiding humans to curling up on the couch in a loving home, Oranges’ story is a perfect reminder that patience, kindness, and a little faith can make all the difference. ❤️
