

#### PAINTING WITH WAX: 4 HOUR ENCAUSTIC WORKSHOP

Five guest limit | \$90 per guest | All supplies included | Ages 8+ | No experience Needed

#### EACH GUEST WORKS AT THEIR OWN ENCAUSTIC STATION IN A SAFE PAINTING ENVIRONMENT.

Each station includes two tables, a R&F Encaustic Palette, Wax Paint, Brushes, Palette Knives, Carving Tools, Heat Gun, Iron, Cray-Pen, Slick Wax, and other various materials used in workshop. Each guest work paints on an 8x10 or 8x8" wood panel. *Additional panels are available for \$15*.

### LESSON PLAN: PAINTING WITH WAX | 10AM-2PM

A FOCUS ON PAINTING APPLICATIONS AND FUSING TECHNIQUES.

We all have different learning styles, and subject matter preferences. We are not all painting the same image.

- I encourage guests to use their own photos as a painting reference.
- Please email photos to jessie@jessiefritsch.com one day prior to workshop.
- Guests can also paint abstractly or use their own personal drawings.

**ARRIVAL TIME:** Students may arrive 15 minutes before the workshop begins at 10am.

**INTRODUCTION TO ENCAUSTICS** | 30 mins: 10am-10:30am

- Including introduction to process, materials, history, and safety.

#### **BASICS OF PAINTING WITH BEESWAX** | 30 minutes: 10:30-11am

- Each quest will be provided an 8x10" wood panel.
- Intro to painting applications and fusing methods.
- Drawing transfers.

#### PAINTING YOUR BEESWAX PAINTING | 2.5 hours: 11am-1:30pm

Individual instruction is given to guests during this time.

- Painting and layering with wax.
- Fusing layers of wax with various heating tools.
- Scrap and sculpting wax.

**COOL DOWN, CLEANUP, AND WRAP UP** | 30 minutes: 1:30-2pm

**ADDITIONAL TIME:** Open Encaustic studio time is available from 2-4pm for an additional \$20 an hour for guests that would like more time working with Encaustic. *Addition hours paid on site.* 











### **Cancellation Policy: NO RUFUNDS**

- Workshops cancelled with proper notification prior to the scheduled workshop will transfer to a future workshop.
- Workshops cancelled without notification will forfeit payment and the workshop will not be transferred to a future workshop.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

**Reservation Policy:** Full payment is required to reserve guest's spot in workshop.

**Experience:** No experience is needed.

**Supplies:** All supplies are included in the cost of the workshop.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

**Safety:** My teaching studio has proper electrical and ventilation to ensure a safe working environment. Slight risk of burns to the hands due to the use of heated tools and palette.

**NOT-Handicapped accessible.** My teaching studio is in an old tavern. There are two steps to get into the building and the bathroom door is narrow and does not allow wheelchair access.

**Workstations:** I can host five guests per workshop. Each guest works at two 5' tables. Students can stand or stools are provided. There will be anti-fatigue mats for each guest. Please let me know in waiver if you are right or left-handed for palette set-up.

**Food/Drink:** You are welcome to bring food and drinks. You may drink at your workstation, but food is not allowed at your workstation. There is a seating area to take breaks if needed.

**Attire:** Please wear proper clothing. Wax does not come out of your clothes easily. An apron is provided. Please avoid sandals due to possible dripping wax.

**Music:** Music is played during the workshop. If you have a favorite musician or style, please let me know on your waiver and I will add your music to the workshop playlist.

**Shop:** Cards, reproduction prints, and paintings will be available during the workshop.

**Guest Arrival**: Guests may arrive 15 minutes before the workshop begins.

**Additional Studio Time:** Open Encaustic studio time is available from 2-4pm for an additional \$20 an hour for guests that would like more time working with Encaustic. Addition hours paid on site.

## **Guest Expectations:**

We all learn differently. We all paint differently. We won't all paint the same image. Each guest paints an image they have selected from their own photos, images, or drawings.

**Teaching style:** I am there to teach you the basic techniques of encaustics and to show you the different tools and materials that are available to you. My teaching style is learning by



doing. I taught myself encaustics with just a book and some supplies. I will demo some techniques, but for the most part I will be asking you to dive into the process and just try it. Each individual painting will have different processes and techniques. Each guest is individually instructed.

**Painting Size:** We will be working on an 8x10" wood panel. Most guests will finish their 8x10" painting in 3-4 hours. If you finish your piece early you may purchase an additional panel to start another piece. If you need more time there is an open studio from 2-4pm for an additional \$10 an hour. Paid on site.

**Reference Image:** Please send me a photo you would like to use as a reference photo. We will be transferring the image onto the board using a carbon copy to save time on drawing. I need to prep the image before the workshop so please email me at jessie@jessiefritsch.com or text me the image at (715-252-4125) by the day before your workshop.

**Image selection:** I recommend a simple image with not a lot of detail. It is difficult to get fine details with heated globs of wax. You may send me a couple of images and I can recommend an image that might would best with encaustic. I usually say stay away from people's portraits. Pet portraits can be great images.

**Satisfaction:** Please set yourself up for realistic expectations. Painting with hot wax is so much fun, but it is also a difficult process that takes many hours of practice to understand the techniques. This workshop is about learning a new process with endless possibilities.

- Tomorrow River State Trail goes right through the town.
