

# YSASP Flow Chart

Law enforcement officer gives youth a Notice of Violation and delivers citation to YSASP.

Youth enrolls in YSASP.

Youth does not enroll in YSASP. Diversion issues the ticket to the youth and the Vermont Judicial Bureau (VJB).

- Program components:
- Substance use screening
  - Reflective, educational discussion with case manager during one or two visits
  - Possible referral to a substance use clinician for an assessment and possible referral to treatment
  - Program fee of \$175 that may be reduced and paid over time depending on individual circumstances.

**Successful Completion:**  
If youth completes all program components, Court Diversion voids the ticket and informs the Vermont Judicial Bureau (VJB) and the law enforcement officer. A letter is sent to the youth confirming successful completion.

**Failure to Complete:**  
If youth fails to complete all program components, Diversion notifies the law enforcement officer and issues the ticket to the youth and the Vermont Judicial Bureau.

Youth admits or pleads 'no contest' and sends payment to VJB.

Youth contests the ticket.

Youth does not submit a response.

Judicial Bureau imposes penalties. See below.

Judicial Bureau imposes penalties or dismisses ticket.

Judicial Bureau enters default judgment and imposes penalties.

**Maximum Penalties**  
1<sup>st</sup> offense: \$300 & 30-day driver's license suspension  
2<sup>nd</sup> offense: \$600 & 90-day driver's license suspension
