#### **Ingredients**

- 2 Tbsp olive oil
- 14 oz. Cajun style andouille smoked sausage
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1.5 Tbsp Cajun seasoning
- 1 lb. uncooked penne pasta (regular or gluten-free)
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream, warmed
- 6 oz shredded parmesan cheese
- Bagged salad

#### **Comments**

This recipe saves you time and money while feeding the whole family. Each serving assumes an average size bowl and this soup can be frozen and stored for approximately 3 to 6 months in a deep freezer. ## **Instructions**


- 1. Set instant pot to Sauté, add oil.
- 2. Add sausage and garlic to pot, cook for 3-5 minutes.
- 3. Add chicken broth, uncooked pasta, and Cajun seasoning, stir to combine.
- 4. Hit Off button to end Sauté, then lock lid in place with pressure valve set to Seal.
- 5. Cook on Manual, High Pressure for 6 minutes.
- 6. When cooking is complete, use Quick Pressure Release.
- Stir pasta mixture together, then slowly stir in warmed cream. Stir in shredded parmesan cheese a little at a time until melted.
- 8. Serve with salad.


## **Meal Cost Savings Comparison**
