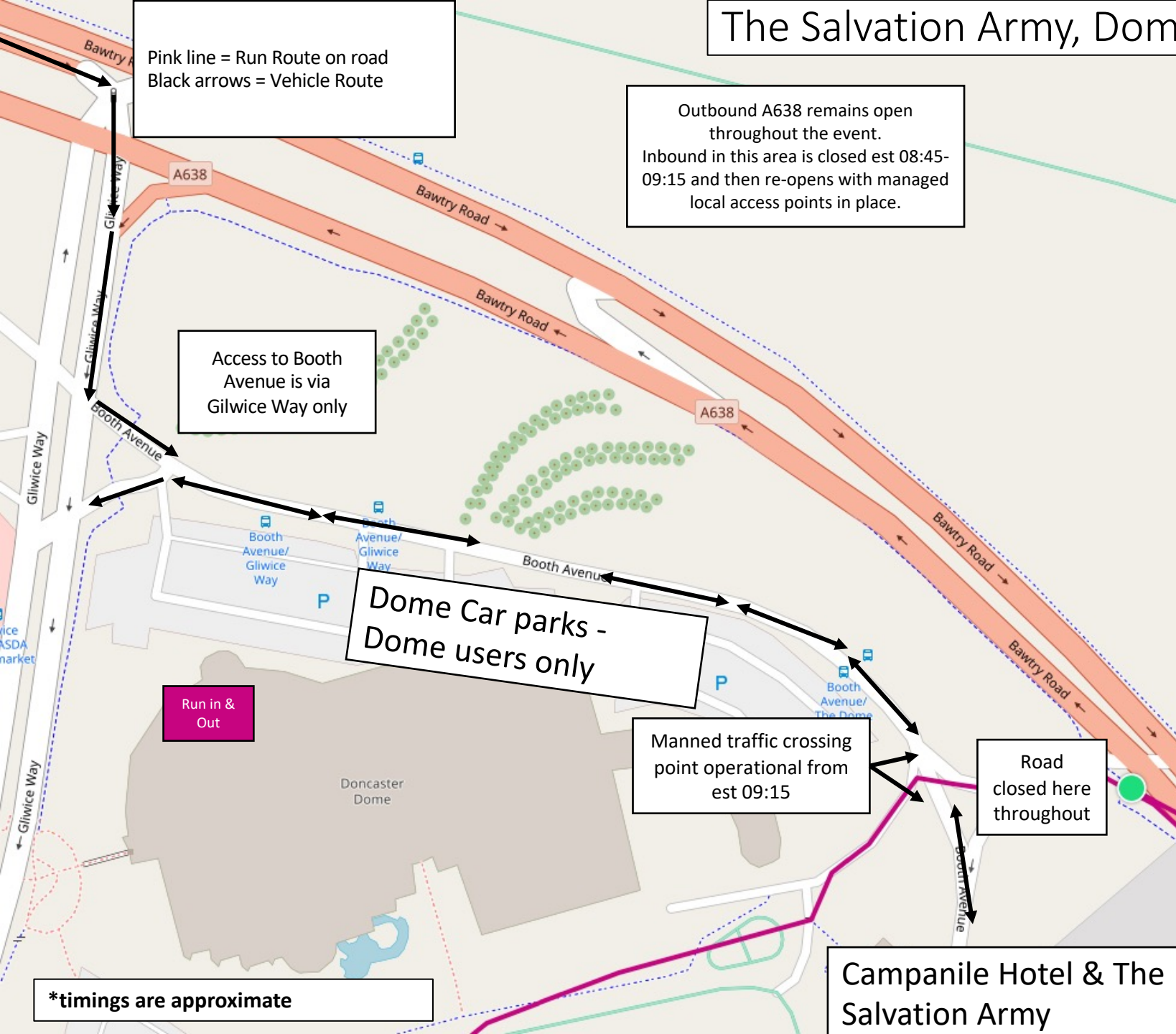


The Salvation Army, Dome gym users & Campanile Hotel



Traffic management in place from 07:30. Runners start the event at the Green dot shown on Booth Avenue. During the mass start around 1000 runners will gather across Booth Avenue so access/exit will not be possible from 08:30-09:10. After this time the area has free and open access until around 10:00 when we expect the runners to return to the area. From 10:00 a manned traffic crossing point is in place as the runners return to finish on the cycle track. Please be patient at this time and wait until you are signaled to cross, it will only be a short delay while a safe gap in the runners appear.

The inbound Bawtry Road from Bawtry direction is closed at this section from around 08:45-09:15 to allow the mass of runners to pass through the Bawtry Road section of the run.

Take care throughout the event, as runners will be in the road. Road closures are in place to support runners' safety throughout the event. If unsure then please interact with one of the traffic team in the area, who will be able to advise you.
