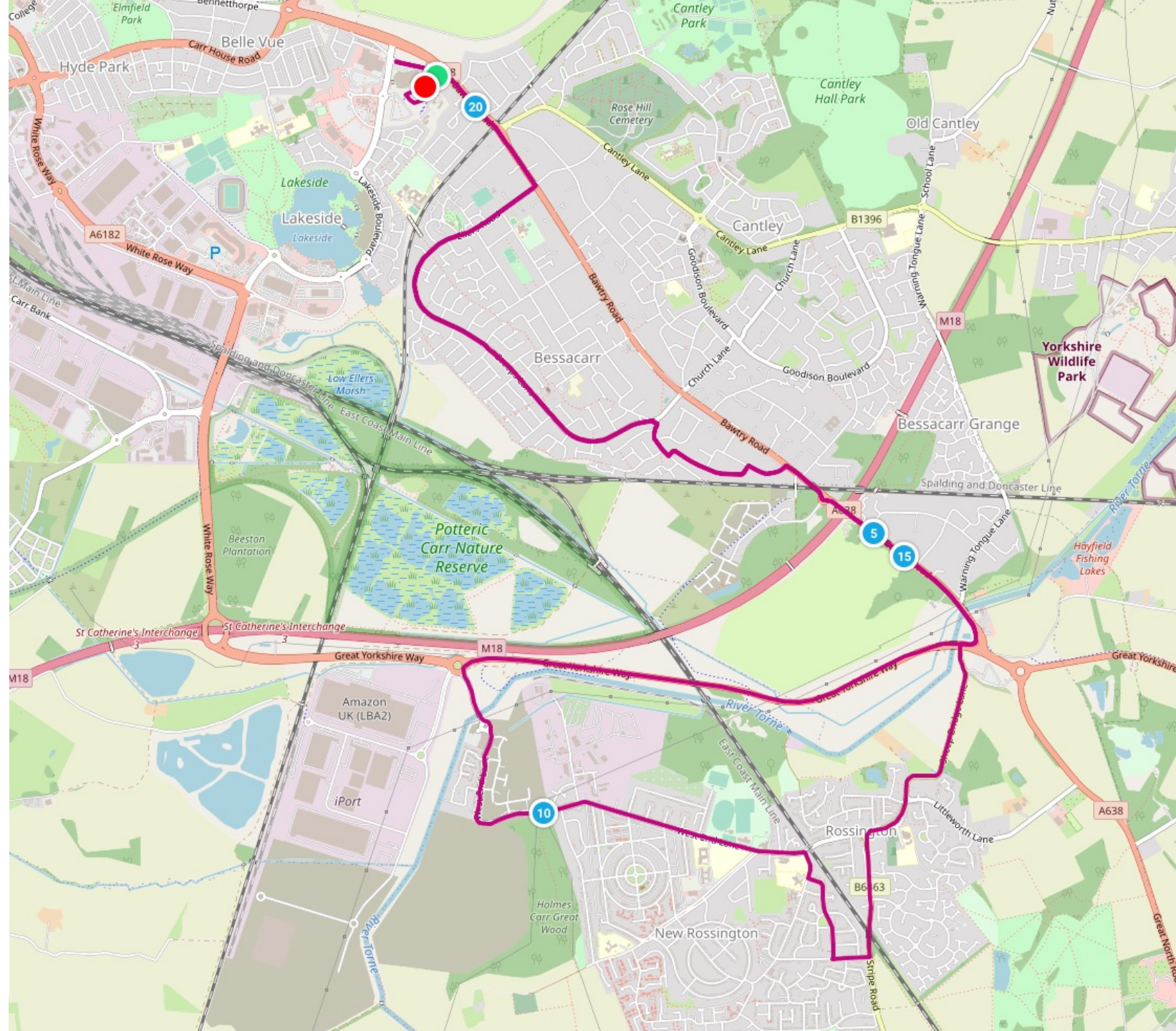


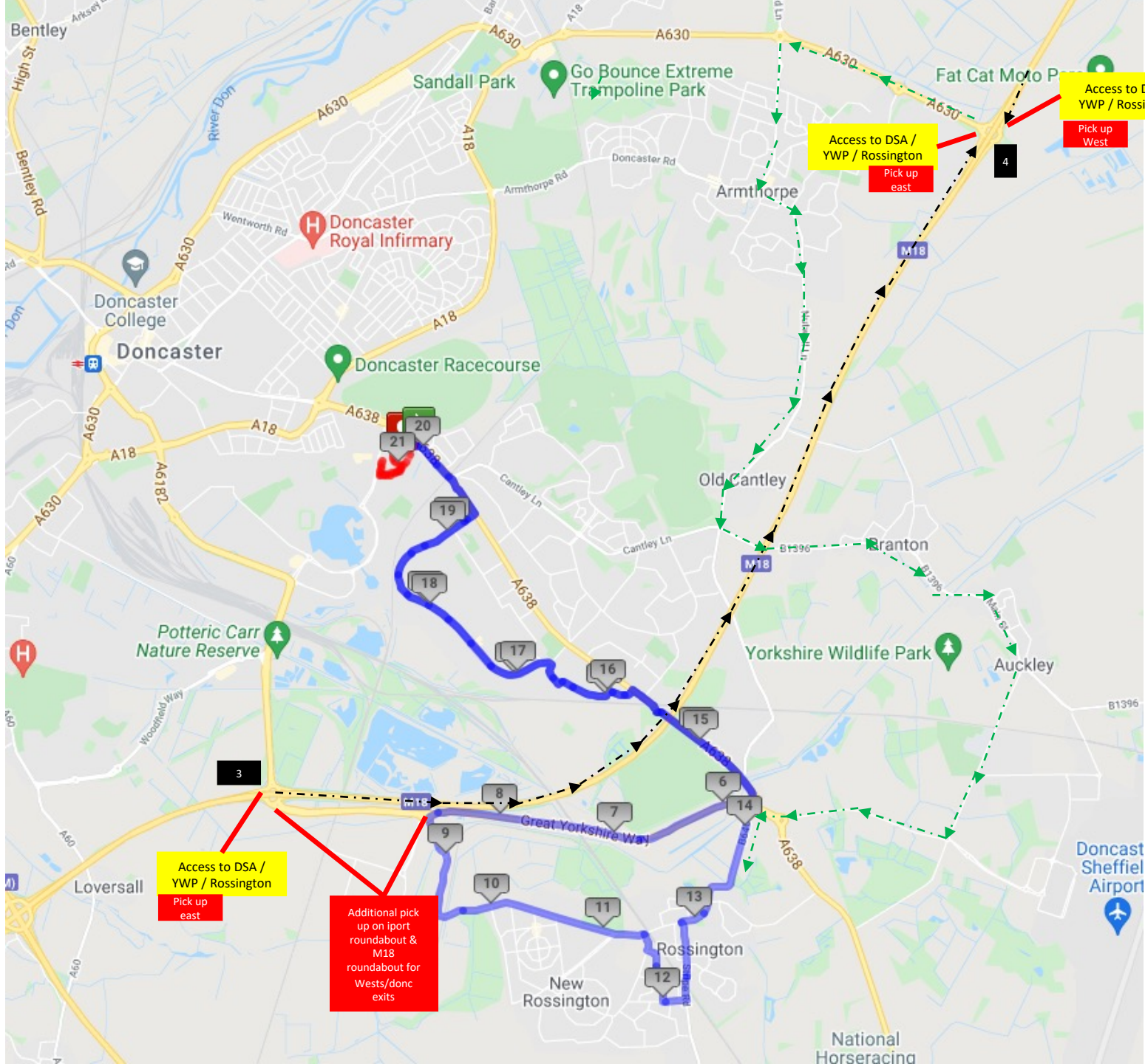
Route overview

Airport/YWP/Rossington access from Motorway Network



A) Heading East on M18

1) Rossington/Airport/YWP - Continue to Junc 4 and follow diversions

B) Heading West on M18 – Pick up at J4 and head via armthorpe.

- 1) **Rossington:** head through Old Cantley / Branton / Auckley / then via hurst lane join Great Yorkshire Way and enter Rossington one way system via Sheep Bridge lane (this keeps the TM away from Bawtry road but access is also possible via A18 / A638)
- 2) **Airport:** head through Old Cantley / Branton / Auckley / then follow signs into airport via Gate house lane (this keeps the TM away from Bawtry road but access is also possible via A18 / A638)
- 3) **YWP:** head through Old Cantley / Branton / Auckley to new entrance (access also available via A18 / A638 / GYW)

Access A638 inbound from Bawtry

C) Doncaster/Bessacarr Turning right onto Great Yorkshire Way heading through Auckley / Branton to Cantley Lane

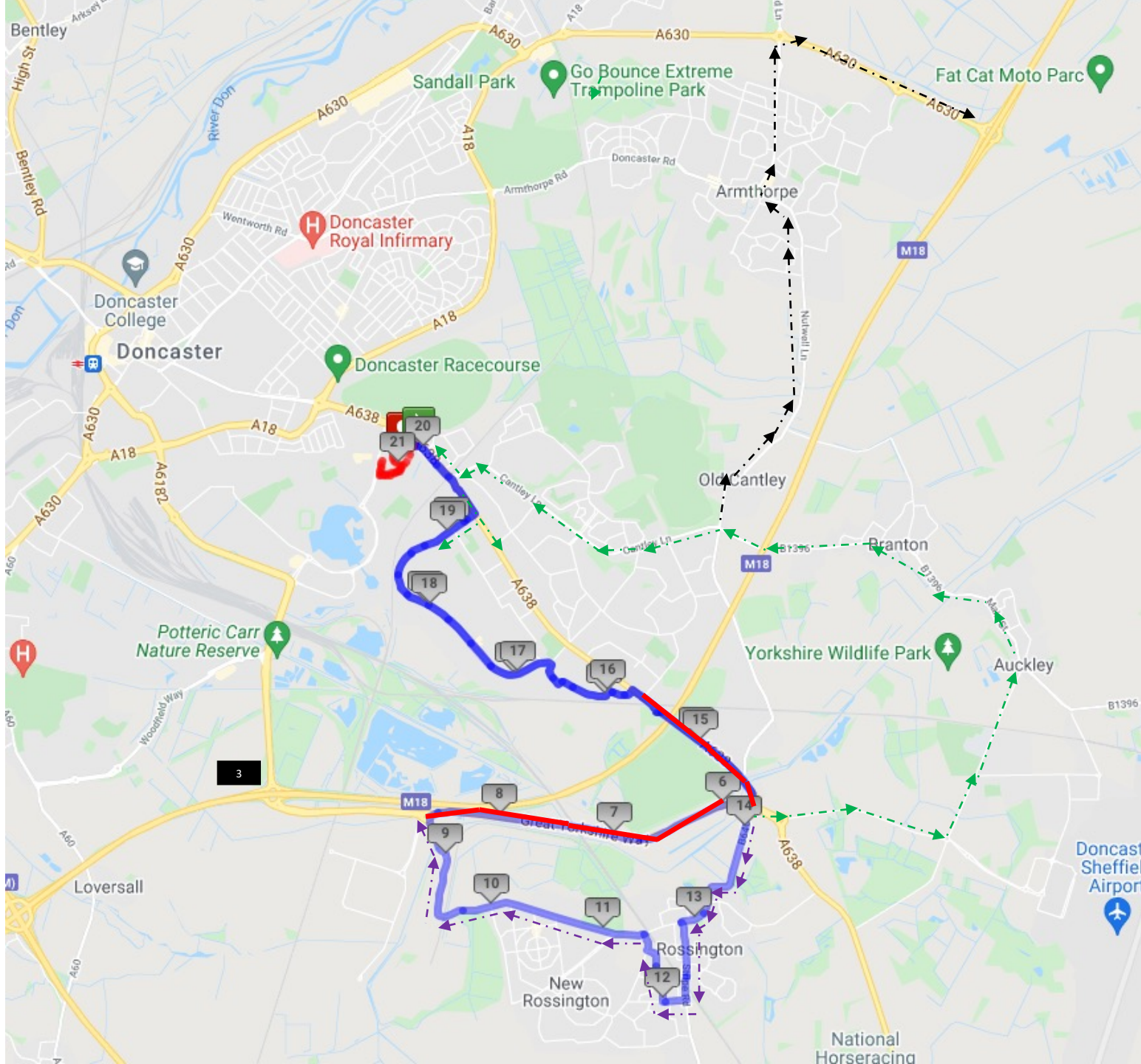
Airport: via big Y roundabout to GYW as normal

YWP: via big Y roundabout to GYW as normal

Heading to Rossington from Bawtry — enter via Sheep Bridge lane (as normal)

D) iport - head north on great north road and then follow one way system in via Sheep Bridge lane, continue to West End Lane and Exit Rossington joining the iport roundabout.

E) M18 J3 – as per access from J4 but reversed (previous slide). Turning right onto Great Yorkshire Way heading through Auckley / Branton / Old Cantley / Armthorpe / A630 / access from junc 4 (can also be through town and onto J3 but this diversion keeps motorist away from run area)
