"Sense of Community" - Discover a new activity, a club or simply create an occasion to come out and have a brew with your neighbour as the runners go past!

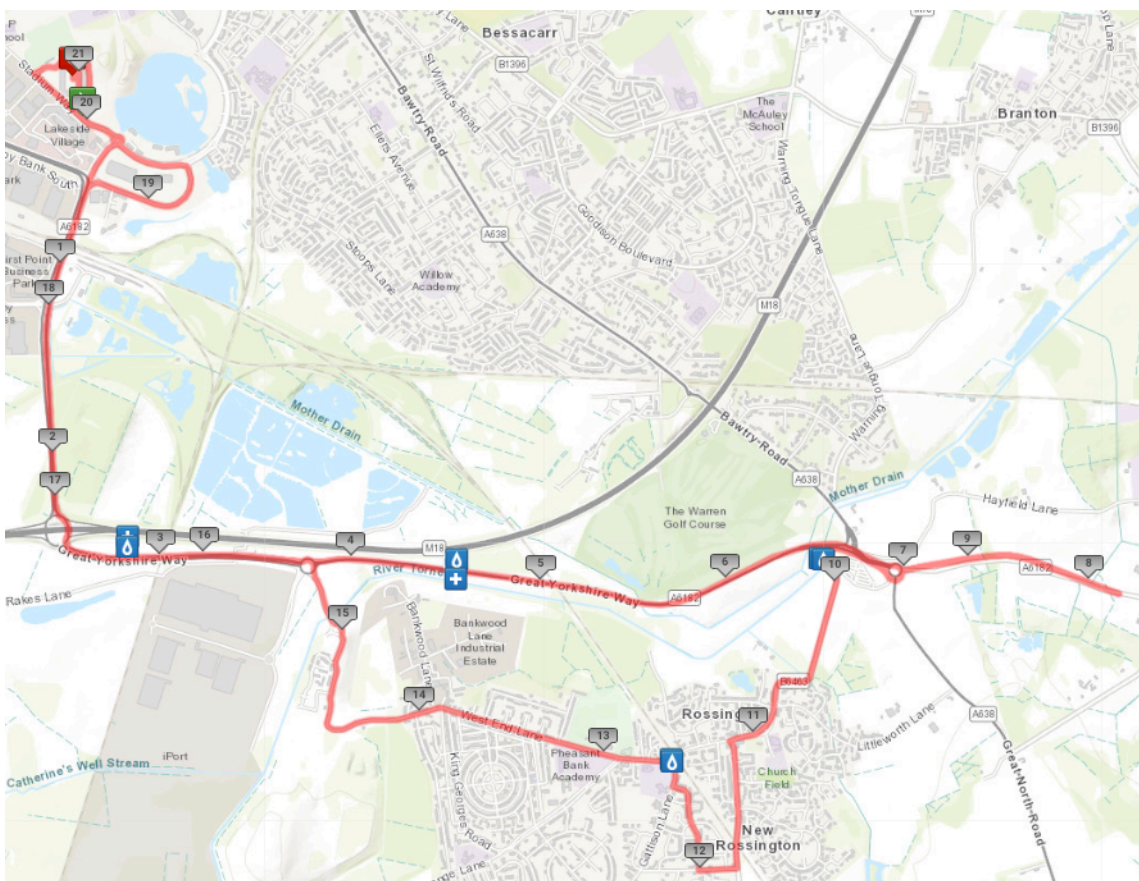
...You can also Get Involved - Volunteer (Volun-Cheer!), Fundraise or showcase your community, school, club or business on the route.

In accordance with Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council (being the Highway Authority) an order has been made prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles in order to facilitate the safe holding of the Doncaster Half Marathon. A full list of road closures, including approximate times, is provided overleaf.

We're aware that this event may cause some disruption from your normal routine and we would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your support of the event.

Traffic management will be installed from 04:00 on-going. We expect this to be cleared for 14:00.

Road closed RUN ROUTE Sunday 9 th June	Details <i>*ignoring roads closures will place you into the path of lead vehicles and runners.</i>
A6182 – White Rose Way	Outbound to M18 - Inbound to Doncaster still available
A6182 – Great Yorkshire Way	Inbound to i-port / Rossington
M18 – junction 3	- No exit from M18 to Rossington - No M18 exit from Doncaster - Exit from Rossington to M18 West (South) bound still available - Exit to Doncaster from M18 East (north) bound still available
A638	Warning Tongue Lane to Great Yorkshire Way Roundabout (<i>except Southbound access to Miller & Carter Pub</i>)
Carolina Way	All (<i>BT & Direct Line Call centre teams access available, please refer to your line manager for details</i>)
Clay Flat Lane	From Stripe Rd to Lansbury Avenue
Gattison Lane	From Lansbury Avenue to West End Lane
Lansbury Avenue	All
Sheep Bridge Lane	Exit from Rossington Closed
Stadium Way	From Carriage Drive to Lakeside Blvd Roundabout
Station Road	Railway crossing closed
Stripe Road	From Clay Flat Lane Heading to Styrrup Pub Roundabout Closed Single side of road
West End Lane	From Gattison Lane to Bevan Avenue
Wilmington Drive	All

Road junction closed and no exit RUNNERS PASSING Sunday 9 th June	Details <i>*ignoring roads closures will place you head on into the path of lead vehicles and runners.</i>
Sheep Bridge Lane – closed at the following road junctions	No exit for Yew Tree Crescent, Greenlands Avenue. Also, no exit from Station Road (impacting New Lane and Kestrel Drive)
Stripe Road – closed at the following road junctions	No exit for Pheasant Bank, Kestrel Drive, Clay Flat Lane
West End Lane – closed at the following road junctions	No exit for The Potteries, Balcarres Rd, Oxford St, Ely st, Newark St, Lincoln St, Cambridge St, Bankwood Lane, Bankwood Crescent
Lansbury Avenue – closed at the following road junctions	No exit for Sherwood Road, Passfield Road, Wilkinson Avenue, Morrison Drive, Cripps Avenue, Smillie Road (also at Clay Flat Lane)
Clay Flat Lane	No exit for Beech Road
Road junction LEFT TURN ONLY joining the one way system RUNNERS PASSING Sunday 9 th June	Details <i>*LEFT TURN ONLY, please take extra care as you will at points be joining the flow of runners separated by cones.</i>
Sheep Bridge Lane – left turn only at the following road junctions	Left turn only - Littleworth Lane, The Carriageway (please note short closures of these junctions may take place during traffic installation for team safety)
Stripe Road – left turn only at the following road junctions	Left turn only – Sylvestria Court, Parklands Close, Brodsworth Way, (please note short closures of these junctions may take place during traffic installation for team safety)
Clay Flat Lane – left turn only at the following road junctions	Left turn only - Elmfield Road
West End Lane – left turn only at the following road junctions	Left turn only - Bevan Avenue, Grange Lane, Grantham Street, Recreation Ln, King Avenue, Henry Av, Henry Lane, King Georges Rd, Granby Lane, Holmes Carr Rd, Heathfields Crescent
No on road parking is recommend on the following roads	Details <i>*on road defined as causing an obstruction on the main carriageway either side of the road (lay bys are fine)</i>
No on road parking on – Sheep Bridge Lane, Stripe Road, West End Lane.	

Additional points:

Rossington one way system – A one way system is in place throughout Rossington providing limited access / exit from the village. This starts at the A638 and brings you in from Sheep Bridge Lane. It will not allow access to all properties so please visit the webpage for more detail. It will then allow exit to Doncaster and the iport via M18 junc 3 and the iport roundabout, leaving Rossington Westbound via West End Lane. Exit via Stripe Road(heading towards Tickhill) is not affected.

Diversions are in place replacing M18 junction 3 and the A638 section. Again, please visit our website for details.

Take care – Our best advice for the day is plan ahead if you're going out. Some areas will not be able to have vehicle access. However we have maintained a one way system throughout the village so parking in an alternative location will still allow you to exit in the morning. Clearly a great piece of advice is to please come out, chat to the neighbours and cheers thousands of runners coming past. Many are running for charity! For some it's their first ever half marathon- some will be running, jogging, walking and wheeling their way around so please show them the Rossington Community Spirit!
