Dear friends, donors and volunteers,

Thank you for supporting Global Impact Homes this past year. This past February our organization brought a team of twelve volunteers to Pondicherry, India for a week working with the Janani Home for Girls. Women and girls in India face numerous hardships that stem from deep-seated gender inequality and patriarchal norms. From a young age, many girls encounter discrimination in access to education, healthcare, and nutrition, often being treated as less valuable than boys. Child marriage, domestic violence, and dowry-related abuse continue to affect countless lives, particularly in rural and underprivileged areas. In workplaces, women often struggle with unequal pay, lack of opportunities, and harassment. Additionally, societal expectations and cultural pressures frequently limit their freedom and choices. Despite legal protections and growing awareness, many women and girls still battle systemic barriers that hinder their safety, dignity, and potential.

The Janani Home For Girls was established in 2013 to provide a safe and structured environment where the underprivileged girls, born into deprivation, can develop on their studies and develop individually. Because these girls are often neglected in society, Janani Home is incredibly important for the improvement of their lives, creating more opportunities in the future.

Global Impact Homes donated dollars towards material and labor, and along with our volunteers we were able to begin the process of remodeling Janani Home as they expand to house more girls.

Over the next fiscal year we have plans to support two new organizations with donations and volunteer support. We hope will continue to support us as we help those in need throughout the world.

Janani Home is affiliated with the Department of Women and Child Development, Govt. of Puducherry and monitored by the Union Territory of Puducherry Child Protection Society and Child Welfare Committee. Janani Home for Girls strictly adheres to the terms and conditions laid by Juvenile Justice Act.

Over the course of the week we sanded and painted, pressure washed, removed flooring and began leveling for the new floor, and prepared the home to add additional rooms in order to house more children. We continue to be the official US fiscal partner for Janani Home through GlobalGiving.





After our week of work we celebrated with the workers before taking off for two nights of R&R in the beach town of Mahabalipuram.
