

Inside-out Orange Peel

4-5" squares background fabric in tan/beige
4 fabric scraps in coordinating colors for peels
Sheerweight fusible

To assemble the orange peel block:

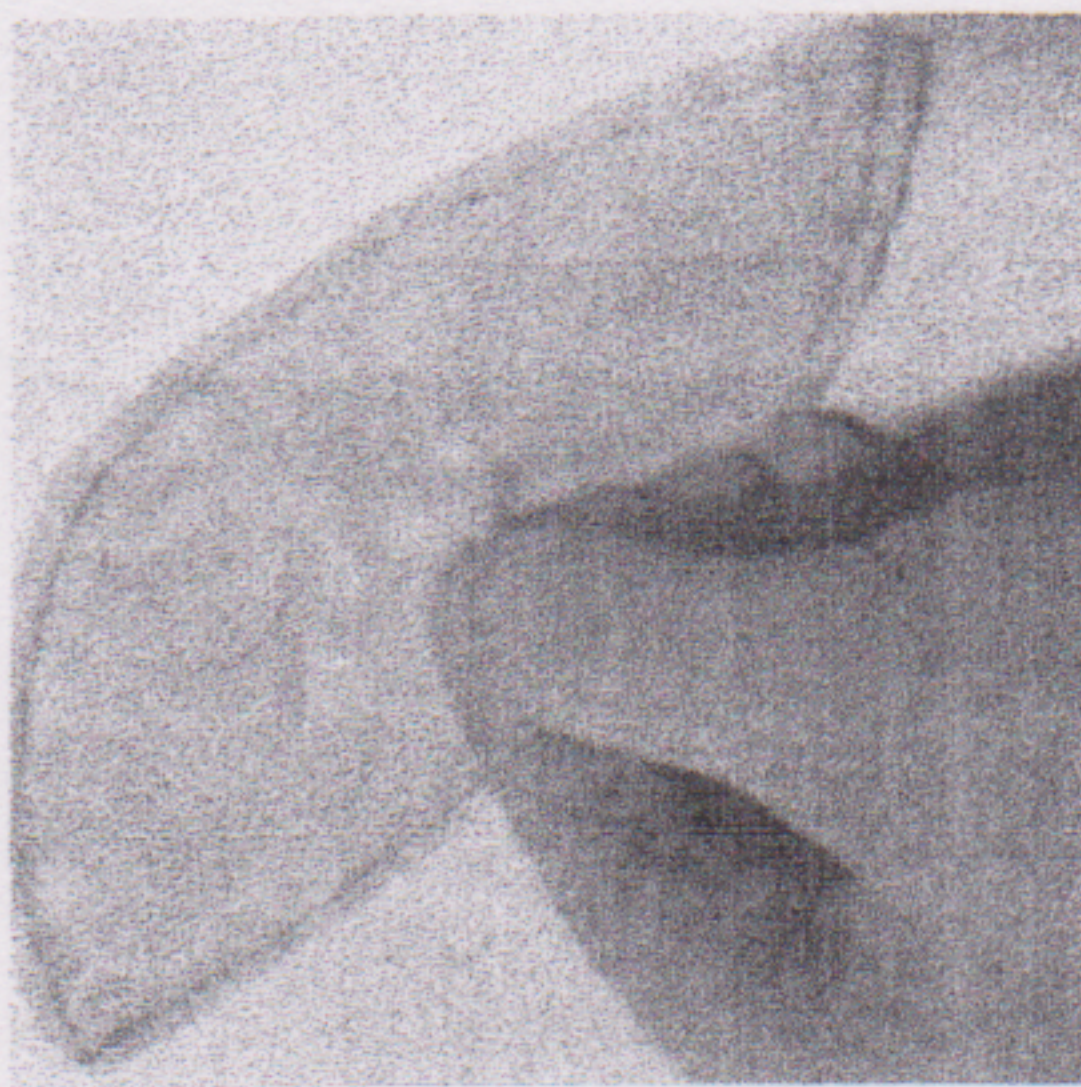
Trace 4 orange peel shapes onto the non-fusible side of the sheerweight. Roughly cut out the traced shapes, leaving about $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance around the edge.

Place one of the sheerweight shapes onto the **right** side of one of your fabric scraps. Make certain that the fusible side of the sheerweight is on top of the **right** side of the fabric. Pin in place to keep the sheerweight from shifting.

Shorten the stitch length on your machine and stitch on the drawn line, pivoting with needle down at points. Trim $\frac{1}{8}$ " from stitched line. Trim across each tip a little closer, being careful not to cut through the stitching.

Gently pull the sheerweight away from the fabric.

Using sharp scissors, cut a small slit in the sheerweight. **Do not cut the fabric!**



Carefully pull the fabric through the slit and turn your peel right side out. Working carefully, use a purple thang or a stylus to smooth the sides and point the ends. Finger press the sides to smooth the edges.
