

GENERAL INFORMATION

QUILT CHECK-IN: Friday, April 2, 2027 / 8:30 am to 12:00 pm. No entries accepted after 12:00 pm.

QUILT PICK-UP: Sunday, April 4, 2027 / starting at approximately 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm

Your CLAIM SLIP must be presented for quilt pick-up.

ADMISSION TO THE SHOW: Entrant may show their CLAIM SLIP for complimentary admission Sat and/or Sun.

RULES FOR ENTERING QUILTS

1. **ENTRY FEES:** \$10.00 for the first item, \$2.00 for each item thereafter. Entry Fee(s) paid include complimentary admission to the quilt show Sat and/or Sun. Non-entrant admission is \$10.00 per day.
2. **ENTRY FORM DEADLINE:** Entry Forms must be **POSTMARKED BY MARCH 6, 2027**. Entries not submitted by that date will not be accepted. All entrants, **including youth**, must use a separate entry form per entrant.
3. **ONE ITEM PER CATEGORY:** Only 1 item will be accepted in any individual category.
4. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE QUILTED:** All items must be quilted through 3 layers by hand, machine, or both. Please Note: Framed entries and entries with false backs are not allowed at this quilt show.
5. **3 YEAR RULE:** All entries must have been completed within the last 3 years. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to accept, reject, or reclassify entries.
6. **HOW WAS YOUR ITEM QUILTED:** It is the responsibility of the entrant to know how their quilt was quilted, especially when quilted by another person. If you don't know if your item was hand quilted, stationary machine quilted, hand-guided moveable machine quilted, or computer-guided moveable machine quilted, then you need to **ask your quilter** so your item is entered in the correct category. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is not properly entered. **The name of the person who quilted the entry must be listed on the Entry Form.** Youth categories cannot be professionally quilted by another, but youth may be assisted by their mentor.
7. **HANGING SLEEVE:** Unless otherwise noted on the Category Notes, all entries **MUST** have a hanging sleeve securely attached to the back of the item. The sleeve must be 4" deep, the width of the item, and 90" from the bottom of the item to the top of the sleeve. Both the top and bottom of the sleeve must be securely attached to the quilt back. The sleeve will not be considered when the item is judged. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to disqualify an item that does not comply with this rule.
8. **CLEANLINESS:** Quilting lines should be removed from the item. Soiled items will be disqualified. All labels on entries will be covered with painter's tape prior to judging.
9. **PREVIOUSLY ENTERED ITEMS:** Any item entered into a previous The Crazy Quilters Guild, Inc. quilt show is ineligible to be entered again.

10. **JUDGING:** Judging will be done by independent judges.
11. **MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES INTO THE QUILT SHOW:** Limited to the first 250 items or when available display space has been met.

13. **REASONABLE CARE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** Reasonable care will be taken to prevent loss or damage to entrant's property; however, entrant agrees not to hold The Crazy Quilters Guild, Inc., Mukwonago High School, Mukwonago Area School District, or Brooklife Church responsible for any and all liability arising from any or all damage and loss to entrant's property. Please be aware that your entries will likely be folded during check-in, transport, judging, setup, take down, and check-out processes.
14. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND SIGNATURE REQUIRED:** All entrants must acknowledge, sign and date their Entry Form that they have read and understand the Quilt Show Entry Information and Quilt Show Entry Form.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who can I contact if I have questions about entering the Quilt Show?

Can I enter more than one quilt per category?

No, only 1 item per category.

Can I pick up my entry/entries early Sunday?

No early pickups.

Can I attach an index card to tell everyone more about the story of the quilt, how I made it, what fabrics I used, what techniques I used, who I made it for, etc?

Absolutely! Every quilt has a story and we want to know yours. Insert the card into a small plastic bag and attach to the front of the quilt with a safety pin. For quilts entered in the GROUP category, please list everyone who participated in the quilt's completion.

What if I am entering more items than the Quilt Show Entry Form allows?

Make another copy of the Quilt Show Entry Form, complete the Section 1: Entrant Information and on the first line of Section 2: Quilted Item Information print "PAGE 2".

CATEGORY NOTES

CONSTRUCTION AND QUILTING: Construction techniques can vary for entries; however, the construction of the quilt top must be done by the entrant(s). Depending on the category, the quilting may be done by the entrant or another.

HANGING SLEEVE NOT REQUIRED: The following categories do not require a hanging sleeve:
Category 18-Garments & Accessories; Category 19-Home Furnishings; Category 20-Miniatures.

HAND QUILTED: Hand or machine pieced quilt top. Hand quilted by entrant.

STATIONARY MACHINE QUILTED: Domestic, sit-down, or mid-arm machine. Quilt moved by entrant or another.

HAND-GUIDED MOVEABLE MACHINE QUILTED: Quilt attached to a frame; machine moved by entrant or another.

COMPUTER-GUIDED MOVEABLE MACHINE QUILTED: Quilt attached to a frame; machine moved by computer. These categories also include embroidery machines that use a computer guided pattern.

CAT# 01-03: 2027 QUILT SHOW THEME: HOOTS, TWEETS & FEATHERS. Birds and flight have been inspirations for quilters throughout the years. You can see that in many of the traditional patterns and quilting designs. What “Hoot, Tweet & Feather” inspires you? Quilt top constructed by the entrant or group and quilted by the entrant or another.

CAT# 16: 1st TIME ENTRANT IN ANY JUDGED QUILT SHOW: Quilt top **MUST** be made by entrant, pieced or appliqued, quilted by entrant or another.

CAT# 18: GARMENTS AND ACCESSORIES: Pieced or appliqued by entrant, quilted by entrant or another. Includes jackets, dresses, purses, bags, etc.

CAT# 19: HOME FURNISHINGS: Pieced or appliqued by entrant, quilted by entrant or another. Includes pillows and quillows, table runners, table decor, placemats, tree skirts, etc.

CAT# 20: MINIATURES: Pieced or appliqued by entrant. A reproduction of a larger bed quilt, on a miniature scale. All elements, including binding and quilting, need to be scaled down. Not a portrait or landscape quilt. Individual blocks no larger than 4” square. Maximum perimeter 96”.

CAT# 21: SCRAP/CHARM: Any size quilt which incorporates 50 or more fabrics. Pieced or appliqued by entrant, quilted by entrant or another.

CAT# 22: NOVELTY-HAND WORK: Any size quilt featuring handwork. Examples: hand applique, hand embroidery, whole cloth, stenciled, cathedral window by hand, yo-yo, cross stitch, crazy quilt. Created by entrant, quilted by entrant or another.

CAT# 23: NOVELTY-MACHINE WORK: Any size quilt featuring machine work. Examples: machine embroidery, cathedral window by machine, whole cloth by machine. Created by entrant, quilted by entrant or another.

CAT# 24: MODERN: Any size quilt which incorporates bold color/prints, high contrast, areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, negative space, and/or alternate grid work. Created by entrant, quilted by entrant or another.

CAT#25: TWO COLOR: Any size quilt which features two colors and/or shades/tints of those two colors. Pieced or appliqued by entrant, quilted by entrant or another.
