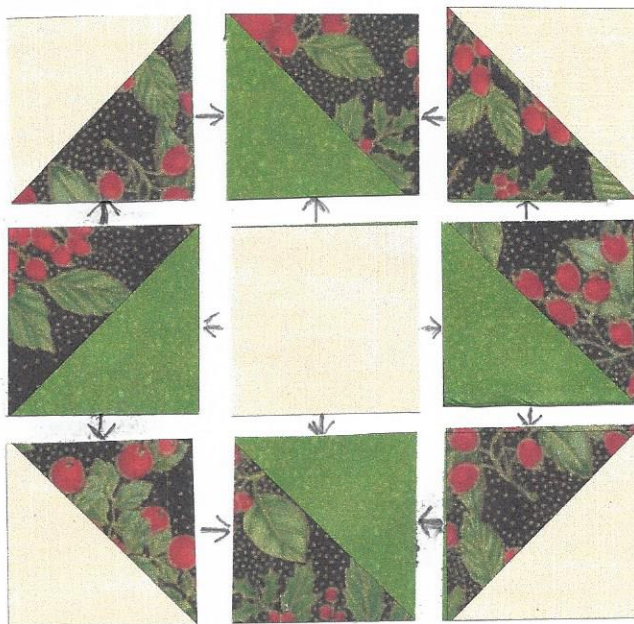
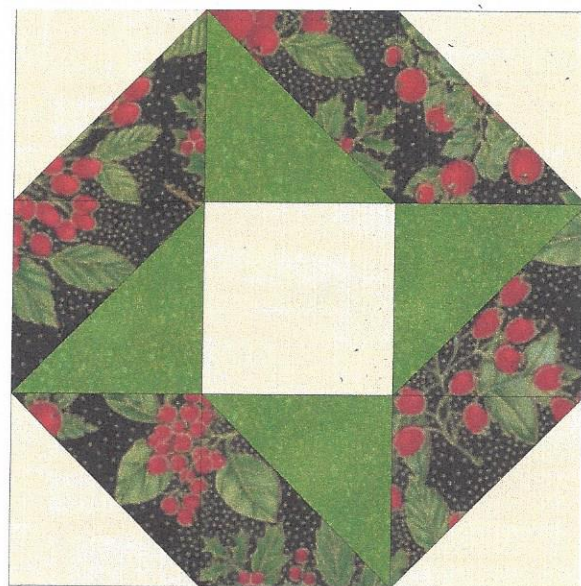


Mukwonago Crazy Quilters: Block of the Month October 2024
 Christmas Wreath: 12-1/2 inches square (unfinished)



Light background fabric: Cut one 4-1/2-inch square (set aside for center) and two 5-inch squares for half square triangles

"Christmas" print fabric: Cut four 5-inch squares for half square triangles

Green fabric: Cut two 5-inch squares for half square triangles

How to make two half square triangles from two 5-inch squares of fabric:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter 5-inch squares.
2. Place fabrics right sides together in color combinations as shown.
3. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, using a scant 1/4" seam allowance,
4. Cut directly on the center diagonal line.
5. Open and press seam to the dark side.
6. Trim to 4-1/2 inches square.



Make four background/"Christmas" print



Make four "Christmas" print/green

Arrange as shown making three horizontal rows. Sew rows together with a 1/4-inch seam. Press seams in top and bottoms rows toward center and center seams away from center square.

Sew rows together and press seams away from center square. Do not trim block.
