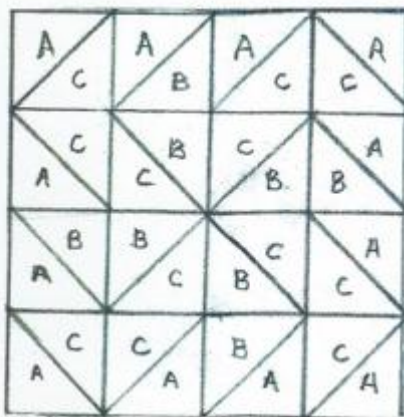


Mukwonago Crazy Quilters: Block of the Month September 2024
Autumn Yankee Puzzle: 12-1/2 inches square (unfinished)



- A: Light fabric: Cut six 4-inch squares
B: Medium fabric: Cut four 4-inch squares
C: Dark fabric: Cut six 4-inch squares

Make two half square triangles from two squares of fabric.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter squares.
2. Place squares right sides together in desired color combination.
3. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, using a scant 1/4" seam allowance,
4. Cut directly on the line.
5. Open and press seam to the dark side.
6. Trim to 3-1/2 inches square.



Make eight light/dark



Make four light/medium



Make four medium/dark

Arrange the half square triangles in four rows with four in each row as shown.

Sew half square triangles in each row together. Press seams in each row in opposite directions.

Sew rows together. Do not trim block.
