Rolling Star BOM for Dec 2023

This block will be due at the January 2024 meeting. Please use **BLUE** fabric from your stash for either the (A) (B) OR (D) pieces and a light background (E) and (F). (A), (B), and (C) can be the same fabrics or different fabrics but all pieces need to have contrast for the stars to show up.

Cutting:

Main Fabric- (A) center, one 3 1/2" square; (B) Cut four 3 1/2" squares; (C) Cut four rect. 2" by 3 1/2"

Star Points- (D) Cut eight 2" squares

Background- (E) Cut four 4" squares, and (F) Cut four 2 1/2" by 3 1/2" rect.

Construction:

- 1. Draw diagonal lines from opposite corners on the back of the (B) and (D) squares
- 2. Place a (B) square right sides together on top of an (E) square with the pencil line placed for making a connector corner. (You will be matching one corner and the (E) square will be ½" larger than (B) on two sides, do not square it up or trim it). Sew on the diagonal line. Press toward the (B) and trim the back triangles off. Repeat X3.

- 3. Place a (D) square right sides together with the (C) rect. Sew a connector corner on one side of each of the four (C) rect. Press outwards and trim. Place a second (D) square on the opposite side of the (C) rect., to create the star points. Sew on the diagonal, press out and trim back triangles.
- 4. Sew the star point (C/D) to the (F) rect. With the star points toward the background (F). Press (see fig 3) toward (F) Repeat X3.
- 5. Sew the blocks together in rows as pictured, pressing the seams in the direction indicated by the
