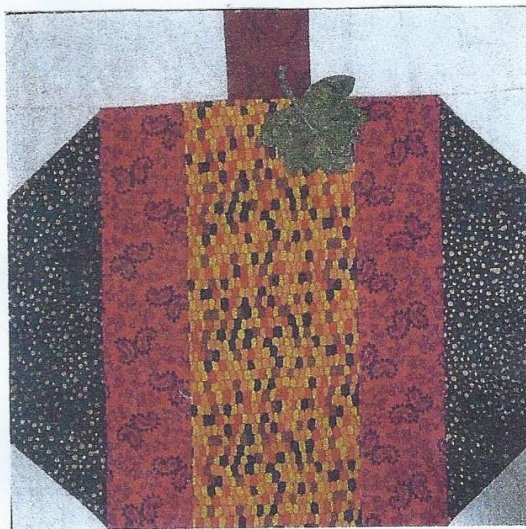
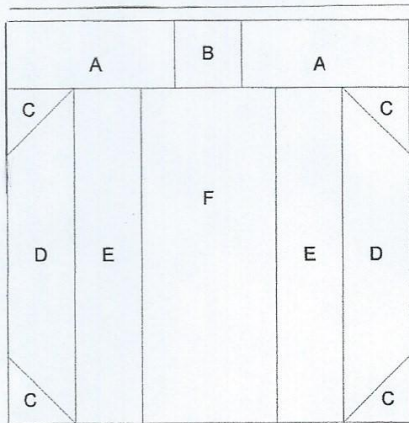


Mukwonago Crazy Quilters: Block of the Month August 2024
Pumpkin Patch: 12-1/2 inches square (unfinished)



Cutting: Background Fabric: (off white or tan)

A Cut two 5-1/2 x 2-1/2 inch rectangles

C Cut four 2-1/2 inch squares (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each)

Stem Fabric: (brown)

B Cut one 2-1/2 inch square

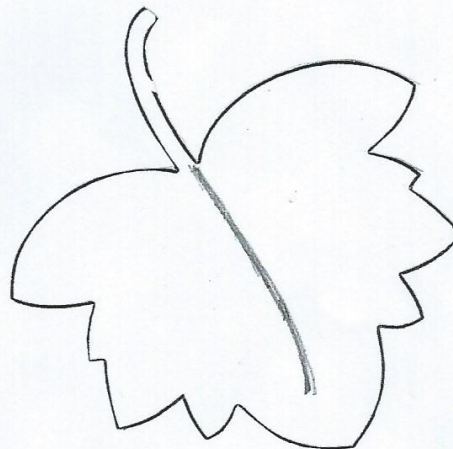
Pumpkin Fabrics: (light, medium and dark orange)

D (dark): Cut two 2-1/2 x 10-1/2 inch rectangles

E (medium): Cut two 2-1/2 x 10-1/2 inch rectangles

F (light): Cut one 4-1/2 x 10-1/2 inch rectangle

Leaf Fabric: (green) batik fabric suggested: Cut 1



Sew a background rectangle to opposite sides of stem square. Press seams toward stem.

With right sides facing, place a background square on opposite ends of both pumpkin D rectangles. Sew on diagonal line as shown. Trim seam and press toward pumpkin fabric to form corner.

Sew fabric rectangles E and D to opposite sides of fabric F rectangle as shown. Press seams toward center.

Sew stem unit to pumpkin unit as shown. Press seam up. Do not trim block.

Place leaf as shown and sew in place, stitching 1/8 inch from outer edge. Stitch leaf vein as shown.
