

Bunny's Nest

BOM for March 2024

The 4" Bunny Square (A) distributed at the March meeting will be used as the center square of this block

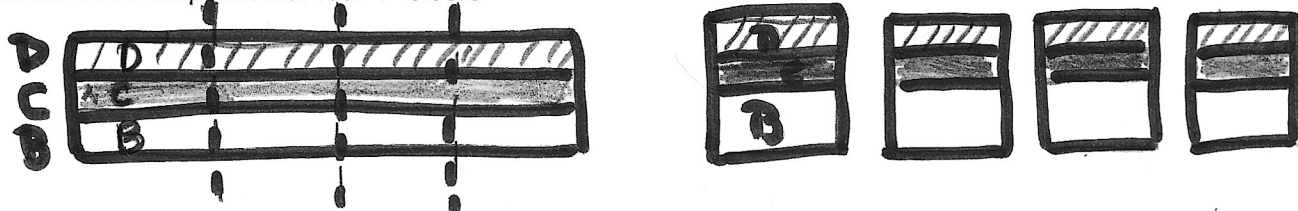
You will need to cut:

(B) Background (white or mostly white fabric): four 4" squares and one 2" by 17" strip

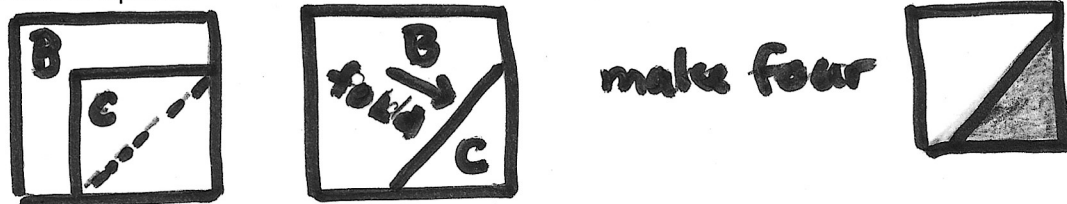
(C) Four 3 1/2" squares and one strip 1 1/2" by 17". This fabric should match a color in the bunny fabric and have some contrast to the background and to the (D) strip.

(D) One strip 1 1/2" by 17" that will look good next to the bunny fabric and contrast with (C)

Sew strips (D), (C) and (B) together making sure that the (C) square is in the middle. Press seams to one side. Cut the three-strip unit into four 4" blocks



Sew one Square (C) on to the corner of one square (B) on the diagonal (draw a line to guide you). Repeat for all four sets of squares.



Arrange your nine-patch block as pictured. Pressing seams so that they nest when you sew them together as indicated by arrows in the picture.
