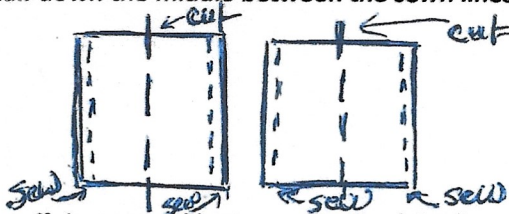


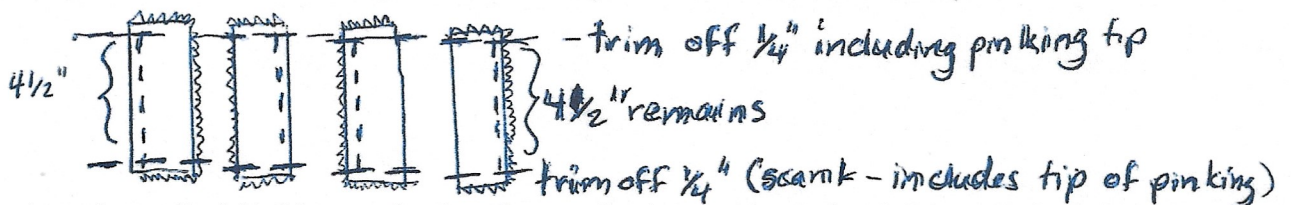
## Mix and Max

Full pattern can be found at [jordanfabrics.com](http://jordanfabrics.com) For this pattern each block will require four contrasting 5" squares (purchased at Guild).

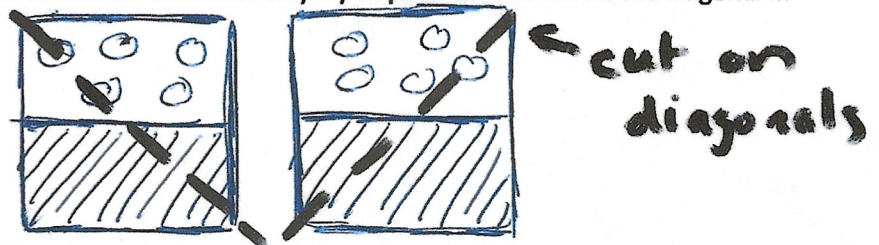
Pair up your squares with a light and dark in each pile right sides together. Sew two squares together along opposite sides with scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Repeat for second set of two squares. Cut each resulting unit exactly in half down the middle between the sewn lines.



Trim off the top and bottom of each of the four sections ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " from tip of pinking edges) to make the length of the sewn line  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Open each unit and press seams toward the darker print.



Layer two units right sides together (one from each color combination) with light on dark, and dark on light, nesting the seam allowances. Repeat for second set of squares. Lay these on the table in front of you with the units arranged exactly the same. Be sure that they lay as pictured and cut on the diagonal in opposite directions as pictured.



Arrange the triangles as pictured making sure the darkest prints (1 and 2) are in position as pictured.

Sew the triangles into squares first (scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ ") making sure the seams match up (pins, repressing if necessary, or pressing open). Then sew the four squares together. That finishes this block.
