## Autumn Rick Rack Logs BOM Oct 2023

- You will be using your own fall-colored fabrics (preferably five different fabrics) and four off
  white/tan prints (also may be scrappy) to create one or two blocks (you can put your name in
  the drawing once for each block you submit).
- 2) For each block, cut the following:

From mixed autumn print fabrics: Cut one each of (A) 2"by 2", (B) 2" by 3 1/2", (C) 2" by 5",

(D) 2" by 6 1/2" and (E) 2" by 8"

From mixed mainly off white/light tan prints: Cut one each of (F) 2" by 6 1/2", (G) 2" by 5",

(H) 2" by 3 1/2", and (I) 2" by 2"

 Sew F to A, G to B, H to C, I to D. Press all seams toward the autumn fabrics. Then sew FA to BG to CH to ID to E. Press all seams toward E.

Your block should finish at 8" by 8" but do not square up your block. Note if you make this quilt 48 blocks (eight rows of 6 blocks each) creates a 45" by 60" quilt
