This makes a 12" block and is from the early 1930's! Reminiscent of the times, let's be frugal about this and do it in old scraps!

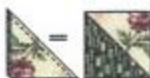

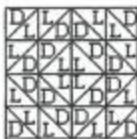
**** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block ****



Cut sixteen 3-7/8" dark and sixteen 3-7/8" light fabric squares in half once on the diagonal.....save half of these for another block, or another project...



Sew each dark half square triangle to a light half square triangle, right sides together, and using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seams to the darker side. Trim to measure 3-1/2" if needed. Make sixteen units like this of all random fabrics...



Now lay out the squares with Dark (D) and Light (L) arranged as shown at left...



Piece the block by sewing four horizontal rows. Join the rows, and it's done! ...on to Page 2!
