Embroidery Club Tips, Tricks and Hacks from September 2024 meeting

TIPS, TRICKS, and HACKS:

- Use medical tape, Binding clips or paper tape to hold extra fabric out of the way while in the hoop. Paper tape is available at the Dolllar Store.
- Use different art media to add color to your embroidery designs. Eileen was nice enough to share the link to show how to do this in a previous email. Thank you for sharing, Eileen.
- Use Vet wrap to prevent fabric shifting while hooping by wrapping around inner hoop. Can be purchased in horse dept at Farm & Fleet or Tractor Supply.
- Use a silicone mat for non-slip hooping. Cheapest to buy a baking sheet instead of from quilt or embroidery shop.
- Use a plate lined with batting or fleece as a non-slip holder or small design wall.
- Use Shelf liner for non-slip hooping or under sewing machine or foot pedal to prevent vibration of machine.
- If there is a hole in fabric or clothing, make an embroidery over the hole to hide it.
- Hairspray, Goop or Oxyclean spray for stubborn stains.
- Pool noodles or pipe insulation to roll projects and prevent wrinkles.Decorative vinyl decals at quilt shops to decorate re-usable water bottles.
