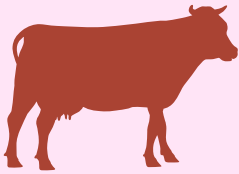

Summary of Al-Baqarah Verse 1-141

Al-Baqarah means
the cow



This surah contains the story of a cow which was sacrificed by Bani Israil (the descendants of Prophet Yaqub عليه السلام - mainly called Jews)



Al-Baqarah is the longest surah of the Quran with 286 verses

The meat of the cow was struck on a dead man. He became alive and informed the others about his killer. This teaches us to prepare for Qiyaamah because we will all be resurrected to give an account of our deeds.

Allah جل جلاله bestowed the Jews with many blessings and miracles. But the majority remained thankless and refused to believe in Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم and accept Islam. The Jews defied both Hazrat Ibrahim عليه السلام and their own Prophets عليهم السلام by not following Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم.



Types of people mentioned by Allah in Juz 1

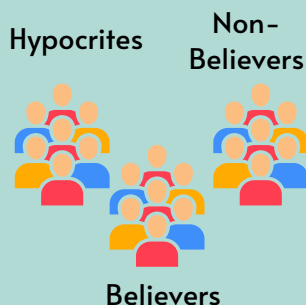
The 1st Juz is called Alif Lam Meem.

It contains Surah Al-Fatiha and 141 verses of Surah Al-Baqarah



Huroof Muqatta'at (طعَاتٌ مَّقُ حروف), like الم in Al-Baqarah, are Quranic words whose meaning is known only to Allah and Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم

There are three groups of humans:
1-M'omineen (believers)
2-Kufaar (nonbelievers)
3-Munaafiqeen (hypocrites)



Signs of Momineen:

Belief in the unseen (غيب), offering salah, give zakaah, belief in revealed books, belief in Qiyaamah

Signs of Munaafiqeen:

lying, deceiving others, making fun of Momineen and Allah's orders, spreading mischief, sinning, ignorance, stubbornness, doubt about religion.



The Story Of Hazrat Adam:

Allah جل جلاله created Adam السالم به عل as the first human being and first Prophet. He lived in paradise with his wife Hawwa السالم البى عل.

آدم



He lived in paradise with his wife Hawwa السالم البى عل. Allah جل جلاله forbade him to eat some fruit

The Devil (شيطان) (deceived him into eating it. This was NOT a sin. Prophets السالم عليهم don't sin. .



Hazrat Adam begged for forgiveness and Allah جل جلاله sent him to Earth with divine orders. Hence, humanity began.
