## Summary of Juzz (Paara) 1

- \* 1st Para contains Surah Al-Fatiha and 141 verses of Surah Al-Baqarah
- \* "فاتح" means opener - Al-Fatiha opens the Quran (it is the 1st Surah)
- \* The Quran contains 3 primary subjects: *Touheed* (Oneness of Allah ﷻ), *Risaalah* (Prophethood of Muhammad ﷺ), *Qiyaamah* (Examination after death)
- \* Al-Fatiha is a summary of Quran: it mentions Touheed, Risaalah, and Qiyaamah
- \* **Lesson from Al-Fatiha: Muslims must make دعا to Allah ﷻ for guidance and paradise**
- \* Al-Baqarah is the longest Surah of the Quran with 286 verses
- \* "بقرة" means cow - this surah contains the story of a cow which was sacrificed by Bani Israil (descendants of Prophet Yaqub عليه السلام - mainly called Jews)

\* The meat of the cow was struck on a dead man. He became alive and informed about his killer.

\* **Lesson: Prepare for Qiyaamah because every human will become alive after death and give an account of his deeds.**

\* Huroof Muqatta'at (حروف مُقَطَّعات), like الم in Al-Baqarah, are Quranic words whose meaning is known only to Allah and Muhammad ﷺ

\* There are three groups of humans: 1) *M'omineen* (believers), 2) *Kufaar* (non-believers), and 3) *Munaafiqeen* (hypocrites)

\* **Signs of Momineen:** belief in unseen (غيب), offering salah, give zakaah, belief in revealed books, belief in Qiyaamah

\* **Signs of Munaafiqeen:** lying, deceiving others, making fun of Momineen and Allah's orders, spreading mischief, sinning, ignorance, stubbornness, doubt about religion.

\* Allah ﷻ created Adam عليه السلام as the first human being and first Prophet. He lived in paradise with his wife Hawwa عليها السلام.

\* Allah ﷻ forbade him to eat some fruit. Devil (شيطان) deceived him into eating it. This was NOT a sin. **Prophets عليهم السلام don't sin.**

\* Allah ﷻ sent him to Earth with divine orders. Hence, humanity began.

\* Allah ﷻ bestowed the Jews with many blessings and miracles. But **most Jews remained thankless and refused to believe in Muhammad ﷺ and accept Islam.**

\* The Jews neither followed Ibrahim عليه السلام nor their own Prophets عليهم السلام by not following Muhammad ﷺ.
