"*Walk-On* is for all those people who've ever walked on to anything, who decided they wanted to do something and set their minds to do it. Maybe they were uninvited. Maybe the odds were against them. Maybe they got knocked down, but they got up and they achieved."

Thom Gossom, Jr.'s barrier shattering story as the first black athlete to graduate from Auburn University is a story of overcoming odds, getting knocked down, and getting back up. His journey begins in segregated Birmingham, Alabama. He dreams of joining the all white Auburn University football team, but in the 1960s no one who looks like him has ever "walked onto a southeastern conference football team and made it." He "walks on," and within a year earns a full athletic scholarship. He becomes a three-year starter. But loneliness and isolation plague him throughout his tenure at the University. Being a pioneer is painful. In a university of 20,000 students he is one of less than 100 black students. Upon graduation, he is drafted into the NFL and does not return to his alma mater for 18 years…but the story does not end there.



History beckons again 30 years later when, as the Chair of the Foundation Board, he successfully champions the first ever One Billion Dollar Campaign at Auburn University.
