Pro.7:1-27 My son, keep my words, and lay up my commandments with thee. Verse 2 keep my commandments, and live Verse 4 say unto wisdom, thou art my sister; and call understanding thy kinswoman: 5 that they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger which flattereth with her words. 6 For at the window of my house I looked through my casement, 7 And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding, δ Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house, 9 In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night; 10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtil(convincing) of heart. 11(She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house: 12 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.) 13 So she caught him, and kissed him, and with an impudent face said unto him, 14 I have peace offerings(have sex) with me; this day have I payed my vows (available or single). 15 Therefore came I forth to meet thee, diligently to seek thy face, and I have found thee. 16 I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry(lace), with carved works, with fine linen of Egypt. Many women brag on being sexual(freaky) and how their bed is BIG and COMFORTABLE. 18 Come, let us take our fill of loves (kick it). 19 For the goodman is not at home, he is gone a lone(out of town) iourney: 21 With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering (sweetness) of her lips she forced (convince) him. 22 He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of stocks; 23 Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hasteth tp the snare, and knoweth not that it is for his life. 25 Let not thine heart decline to her ways, go not astray in her paths. 26 For she hath cast down many wounded: yea, many strong men have been slain by her. 27 Her house is the way to HELL, going down to the chambers of death.
