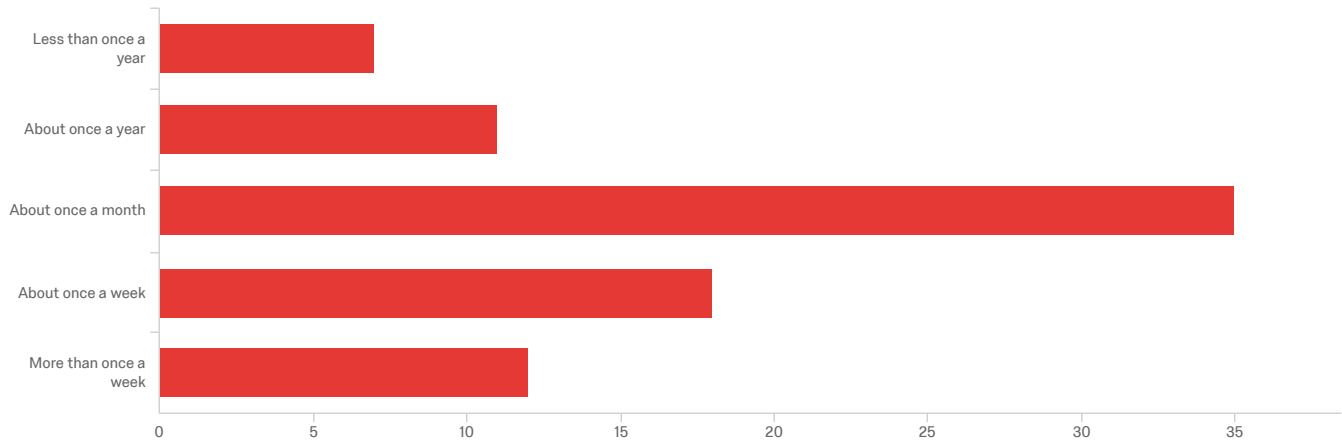

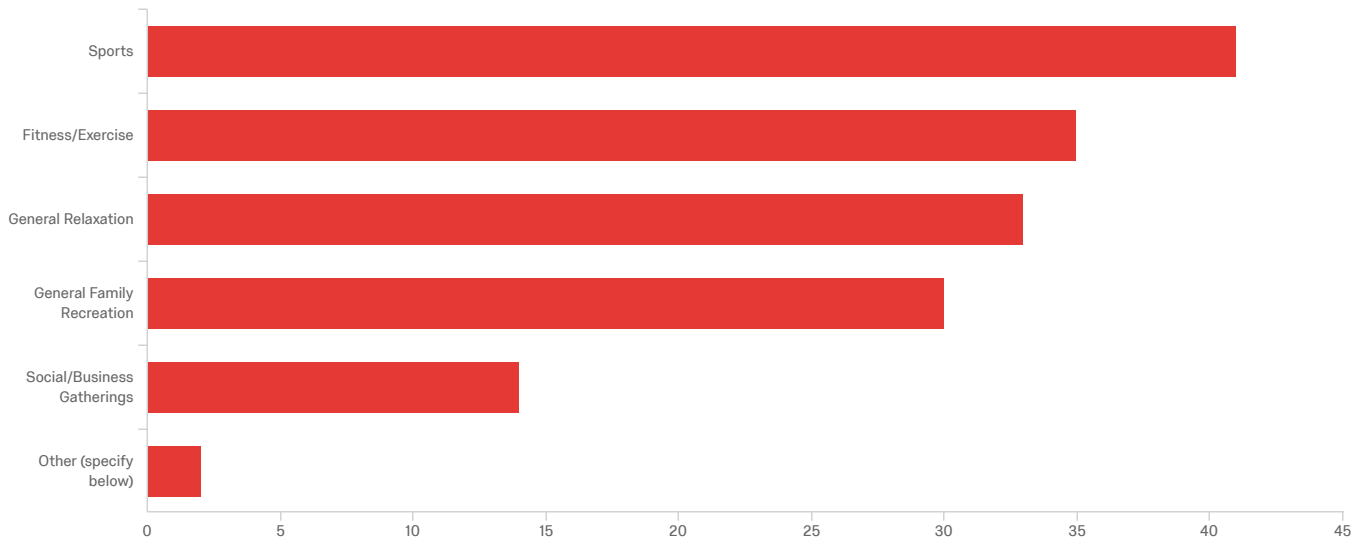

I walk in the parks approx 3 times during the week in good weather, mainly May through end of October.

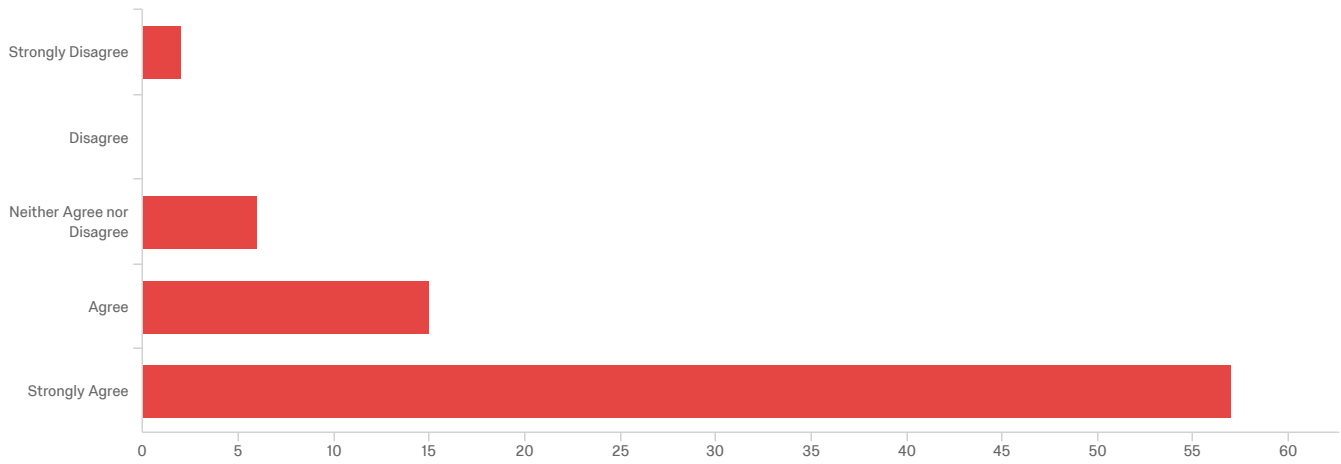

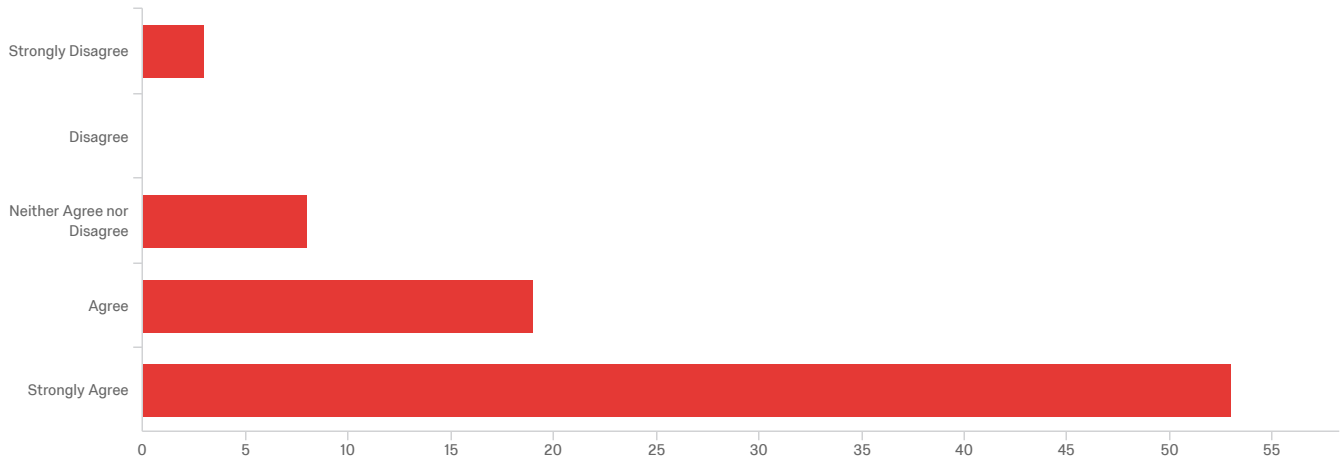

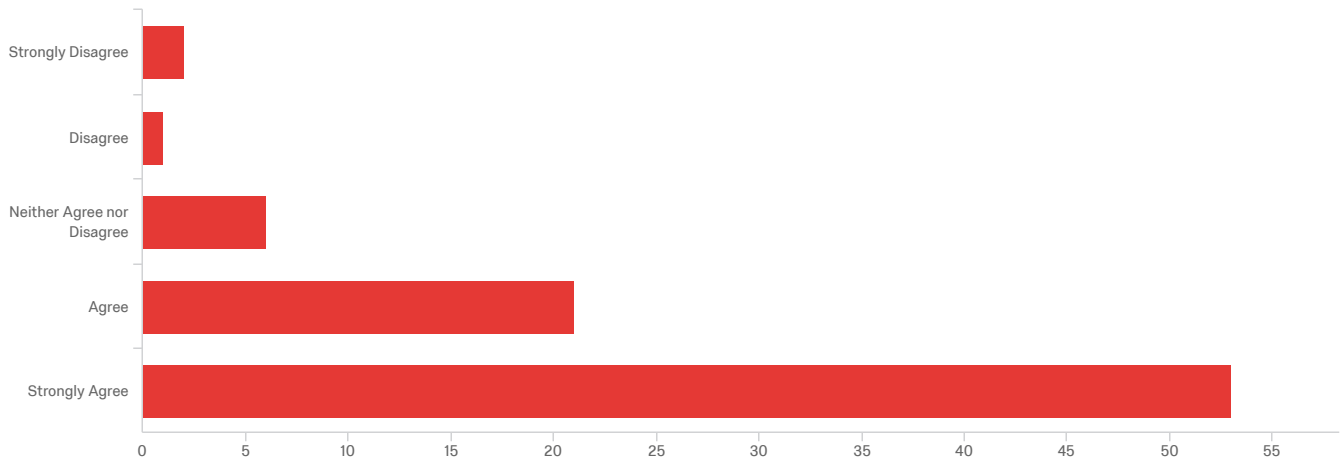

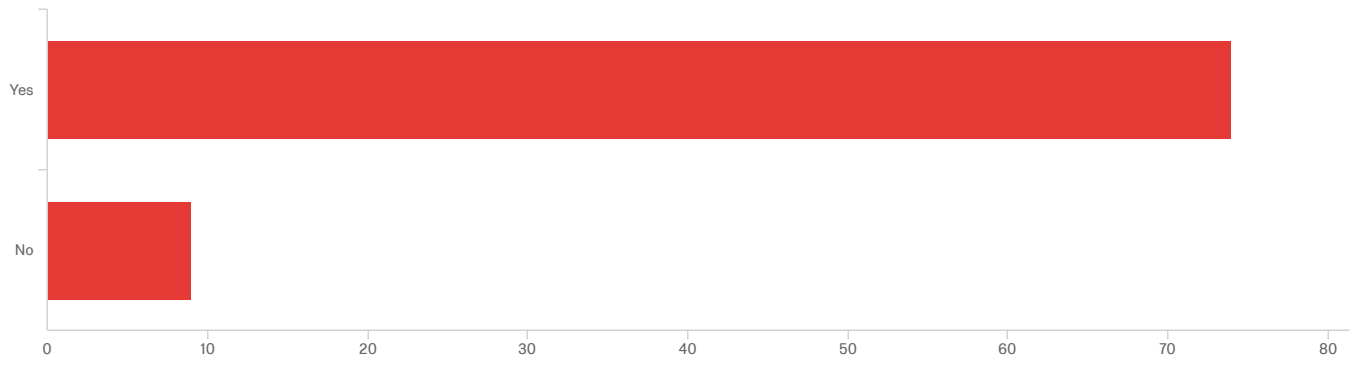

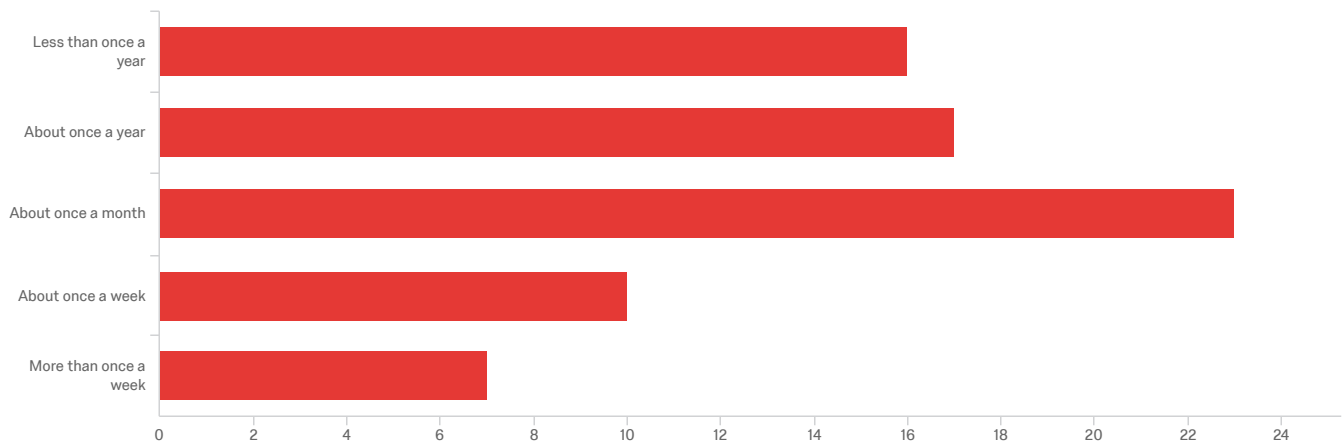

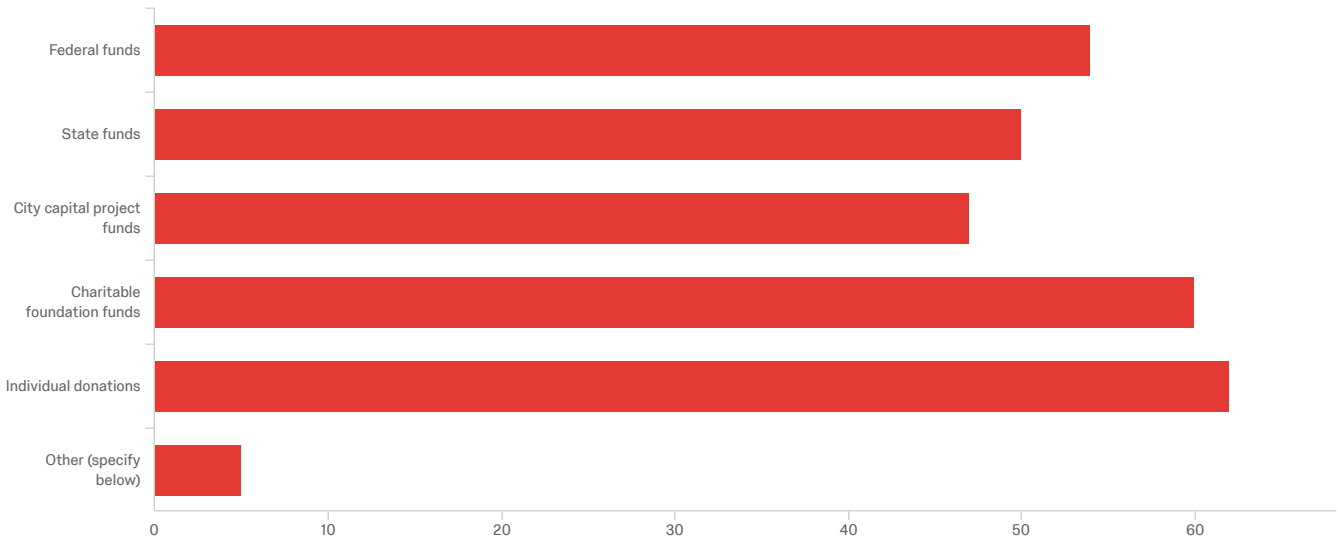

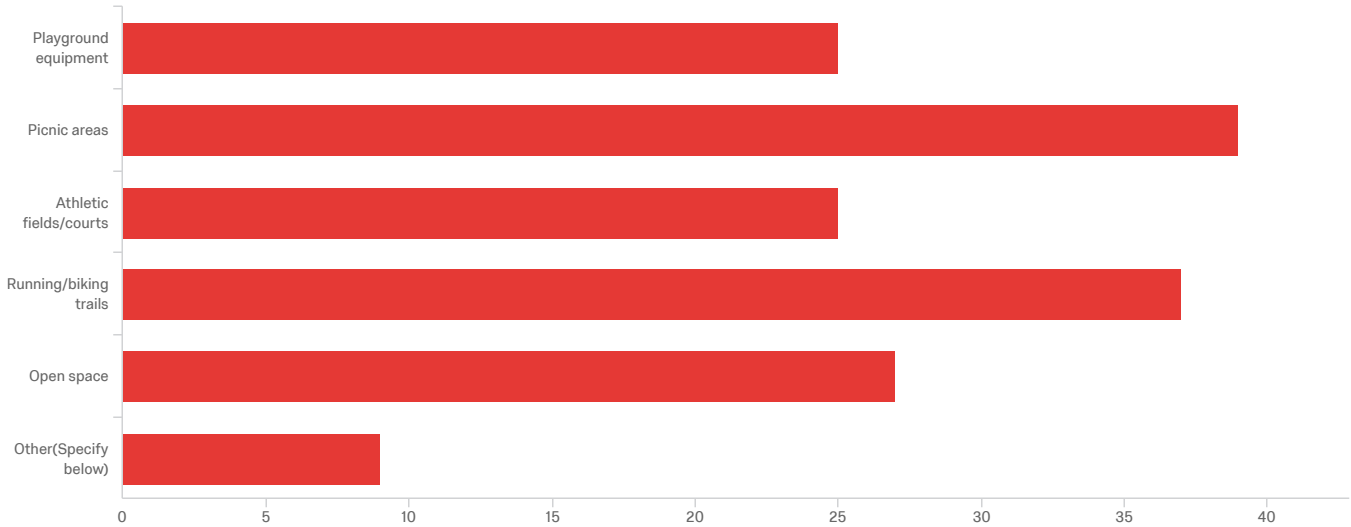

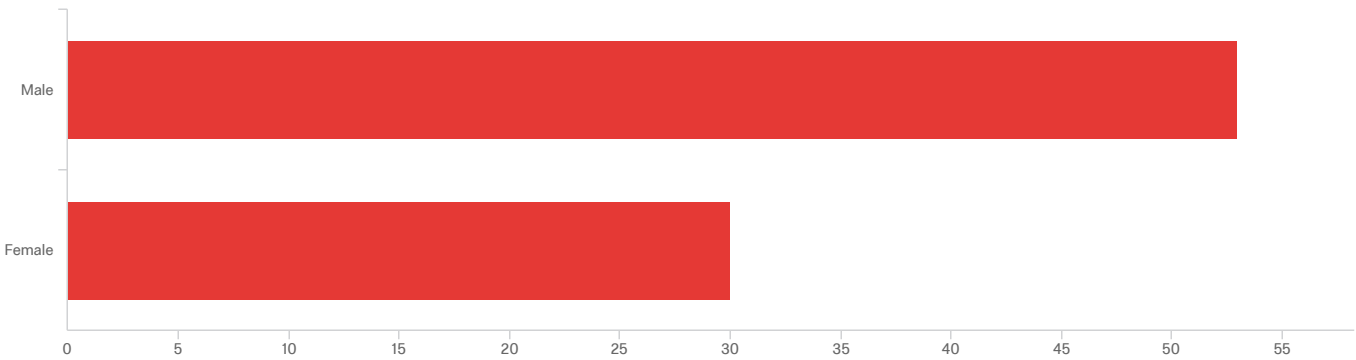

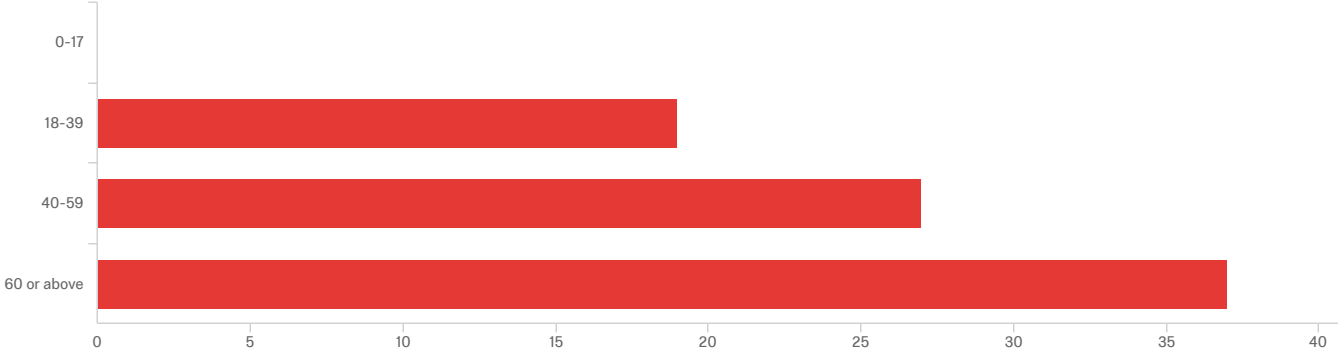

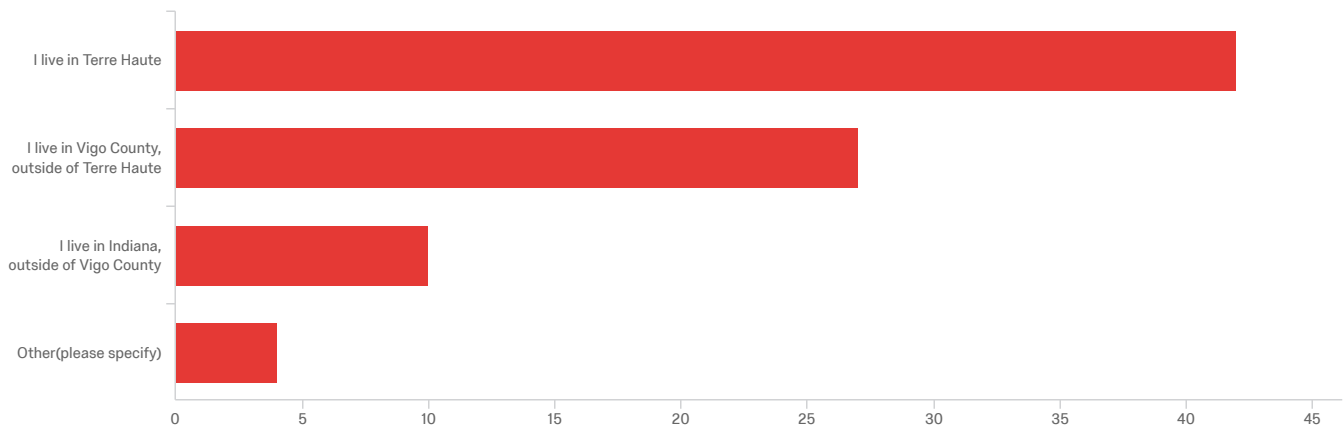

The green fees are too high for the general public making this city park feel "exclusive" leaving many residents feeling left out of utilizing this space. An effort needs to be made to make this park more welcoming to the public.

Save the clubhouse First! Trails, quality restaurant befitting the style of the space....NOT A STEAKHOUSE OR CHAIN! GolfCourse, Pickle ball, Tennis, waterpad after. Be careful with "shelters/picnic tables". Not compatable with a wedding venue. Perhaps a Permanent peaked event tent instead. Try to elevate the usage for more formal events. Perhaps official croquet grass courses with tournaments annually. Summer whites dress code. Befitting the 1920s. Terre Haute has enough parks with shelters for the general public. We do not need another. It would be a shame to down dress such a once prestigious place. I would not donate monies for such a plan as that. But would happily contribute to a tasteful upscale rehab. Let T Kleckner be your guide. Have worked with him on boards. He is knowledgeable.

Rea Park is a staple to the community of Terre Haute. The course brings great pleasure to its players and needs to be kept in good shape. I've been a loyal player of Rea Park for 10+ years and care greatly for its well being. I hope that these renovations occur. GOLF MATTERS

I now live in Indianapolis; attended and graduated from ISU in 1983. Still return frequently for golf outings, basketball games, ISU homecoming (31 years in a row). I have many fond memories of playing golf at Rea Park and would willingly donate to preserve and renovate this facility.

I believe Rea Park clubhouse should be renovated to maintain its architectural history and preserve it for the future. I think adding onto the clubhouse is a poor use of funds (increased annual maintenance and operation costs, which the city cannot afford). The clubhouse has been mostly empty for years, with only a snack bar and small clubhouse/pro-shop. In my opinion, it is in bad taste to attempt to turn Rea Park into a community center, wedding venue adding to the annual costs of a park that is currently not economically sustainable. I would be all for this if a private developer purchased Rea Park (golf course, clubhouse.....) but using any amount of tax money is a terrible idea. If you are having money funding what you already have, you do not add to the pile.

Please update restroom facilities at golf course, especially for the women. Currently, they have to go upstairs then downstairs, then back up again. After I broke my hip, I could no longer access the facility for a long time easily.

Who plays golf anymore? You need something that may engage many more people.

As I do not golf, I have never used this Rea Park, making it more appealing to all would be a benefit.

The Graham Grain Line Trail that would connect Rea Park to the city would allow for many residents of all ages to access the renovated facilities and enjoy exercise to and from the park. The Graham Grain trail would provide a walking/biking link that would be very close to existing trails along Hulman and South Fourth Streets. This new trail link would be useful for both ISU students and faculty, along with South Vigo HS students.

William S. Rea Park could be developed into a tremendous asset for the south side of Terre Haute to host any number of events for individuals and businesses. I grew up 2 blocks north of Terre Haute South and spent virtually every day of my summer there playing tennis or golf. It should be brought back to it's grandeur and be promoted as an asset of Terre Haute.

I would favor restoring the historical ambience of the place. The restrooms were in dire need of work the last time I was there.
