8	Whakapapa Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) <i>Superb wine from Gisborne (North Island) offering something different to the usual Marlborough Sauvignon. Young and fresh with gooseberry and green apple, softened by flavours of tropical fruit.</i>	 	£25.00

<i>Brooding deep red in colour with black fruit aromas and flavours of cherries and plums. A lovely medium-bodied Malbec which is great with any red meat and cheese dishes.</i>			
15 Santa Luz 'Alba' Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile)			£18.75
<i>Rich in colour, aroma and depth, this Cabernet Sauvignon shows notes of juicy, ripe berries on the nose, flavours of cassis and cherry on the palate and a rounded, pleasant finish.</i>			
16 Ca di Alte Pinot Nero (Pinot Noir, Italy)			£22.00
<i>This light, fruity and perfumed Pinot Nero puts many a Burgundy to shame. With perfumes of cherries, strawberries and violets, it has an attractive touch of sour cherry on the finish.</i>

<i>A rich, well balanced example of this Aussie classic blend. Lush black fruits coupled with touches of spice, liquorice and cassis follow through to a delicious, velvety finish.</i>
