

Called to Speak, Ready to Hear

Romans 10:14 (NKJV)

“How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?”

This verse confronts us with a sobering and hopeful reality: faith does not arise in a vacuum. God, in His wisdom, has chosen to work through human voices to proclaim a divine message. Belief begins when truth is heard, and hearing requires someone willing to speak. The gospel moves from heart to heart through faithful proclamation, obedient witness, and the sharing of God’s redemptive story.

Paul’s words remind us that salvation, though entirely God’s work, is carried forward through God’s people. The message of Christ must be spoken clearly, lived authentically, and shared courageously. Silence leaves a void where truth should be, but obedience opens the door for faith to take root.

The Lesson: Faith That Is Heard

Calling follows believing: No one calls upon Christ without first believing in Him. Faith must be informed by truth, not assumption or tradition.

Belief requires hearing: God uses spoken truth—His Word proclaimed—to awaken faith. Hearing the gospel is the doorway through which belief enters.

Hearing depends on obedience: God sends messengers. Whether through preaching, teaching, or everyday conversation, His message advances when His people speak.

As the days ahead unfold, may your heart remain open to hearing God’s truth, and may your life be ready to speak it. May courage replace hesitation, clarity overcome fear, and love guide your words. The gospel you have heard is the hope someone else is waiting to receive.
