Scott Farm Orchard

Dummerston, Vermont

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, Scott Farm has been a working farm since 1791 and currently grows over 130 certified ecologically grown varieties of heirloom apples and fine fruits. The 571 acres of land features hillside fields with picturesque vistas, peaceful ponds, orchards, woodland trails, artful stone walls and sculptures by The Stone Trust, and a seasonal farm store.
