Our approach focuses on reducing environmental impact where reasonably practicable, protecting biodiversity, and complying with relevant environmental legislation.

We seek to reduce our environmental impact by minimising waste and promoting reuse and recycling of arisings where possible. Works are planned to reduce unnecessary travel through local working and efficient scheduling. Plant and equipment are maintained to ensure efficient operation and reduce emissions, and unnecessary vehicle or machinery idling is avoided.

As an arboriculture and vegetation management contractor, we place strong emphasis on protecting wildlife and natural habitats. Nesting bird and protected species checks are undertaken where applicable, and works are timed and managed to reduce ecological disturbance. Trees are retained and managed in line with best arboricultural practice wherever reasonably practicable.

Materials, fuels, and resources are used responsibly and sourced from reputable suppliers. Environmental controls are implemented through risk assessments, method statements, and site supervision.

Environmental performance is reviewed periodically to identify opportunities for improvement and to ensure this approach remains appropriate to the size, nature, and scale of the business.
