Calvinism's Corruption: Irreverent, Irrational, Irreconcilable

"But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be **corrupted** from the simplicity that is in Christ. For if he that cometh preacheth **another Jesus**, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive **another spirit**, which ye have not received, or **another gospel**, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him" (2 Corinthians 11:3,4).

Irreverent to the Savior "another Jesus..."

"For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior; who will have all men to be saved... Christ Jesus... gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time" (1Timothy 2:3-6).

"Come unto me, <u>all ye</u> that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls" (Matthew 11:28,29).

I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!... When He was come near, He beheld the city, and wept over it, saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! But now they are hid from thine eyes" (Luke 13:34; 19:41,42).

Irrational toward the Spirit "another spirit..."

"Come now, and let us <u>reason</u> together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool" (Isaiah 1:18).

"Turn you at My reproof: behold, I will pour out My Spirit unto you, I will make known My words unto you... they shall not find Me: for that they hated knowledge and did not choose the fear of the LORD" (Proverbs 1:23-29).

"And when He [the Comforter] is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment" (John 16:8).

"Ye stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always <u>resist the Holy Ghost</u>: as your fathers *did*, so *do* ye" (Acts 7:51).

"Wherefore, as the <u>Holy Ghost saith</u>, Today if ye will hear His voice, <u>harden not</u> your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness" (Hebrews 3:7-8).

Irreconcilable with the Scriptures "another gospel..."

"The angel said... Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to <u>all people</u>. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:10,11).

"For God so loved the <u>world</u>, that He gave his only begotten Son, that <u>whosoever</u> believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to <u>every one</u> that believeth... God hath showed it unto them... so that they are <u>without excuse</u>" (Romans 1:16-20).

"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, <u>not willing that any should perish</u>, but that <u>all should come to repentance</u>" (2 Peter 3:9).

"All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all" (Isaiah 53:6).

"God... now commandeth <u>all</u> men <u>everywhere</u> to repent" (Acts 17:30).
