## The false teaching of the Roman Catholic Church

denies the Biblical truths regarding the singular way of salvation through Christ alone and the eternal security of the those who receive Him (and are thus born of God), based solely on the unmerited grace of our Lord. (John 1:12,13; 14:6; Ephesians 2:8,9; Titus 3:5).

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1030-32; 1471-1479), the merits of the elect go into the church treasury in heaven, so that they may be distributed to the faithful in purgatory who are yet being purified for their salvation.
