

VIEWING DISTANT STARLIGHT in a YOUNG UNIVERSE





The trampoline represents the fabric of space that God "stretcheth out... as a curtain" (Isaiah 40:22). A weighted red ring represents the "waters which were above the firmament" creating a flat space (firmament) in the center of the fabric,. The red ball in the center represents "the waters which were under the firmament."

"And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so. And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day." (Genesis 1:7,8).

The new metric (solution of Einstein's gravity equations) that Dr. Russel Humphreys developed to describe the relationship among mass, space, and time says that the distribution of mass controls the fabric of space, the fabric of space controls the speed of light, and the speed of light controls time.
