
TOPCOATING DETAIL / TRIMS

The trims, corners and any areas of detail should be topcoated before the main body of the roof.








Follow the same preparation instructions as for the resin. Stir the topcoat in the pail before decanting.


The topcoat should have hardener added in the same way as the resin. Follow the instructions on the Cure It mixing bucket.





Use a section of flat trim under A200 /B260 to protect any new fascia. Replace any guttering at this stage. Use a small roller or brush for the trims, corners and any areas laminated during the bandaging stage.

TOPCOATING





Within 24 hours the roof should be completely cured. Do not apply water unnecessarily to the roof before this point.
