Ah, yes, the patios! Summer is here and there is nothing like a nice

grilled steak on a Saturday night! Please be aware that grills on the patios are not allowed! They are a fire hazard and in a community setting, that can put **A LOT** of people at risk!

- The Phoenix Fire Code prohibits the use of charcoal burners, propane and other open-flame cooking devices, as well as liquid fuel on fire escapes or balconies, patios, covered w alkw ays or roof overhangs.
- Please REMOVE ALL GRILLS from your patios, including any bottles of propane or liquid fuel.

POOL!

bathing, dips in the pool, and playing Marco-Polo is the joy of summer! And heaven knows we need the cool, refreshing break from the Arizona summer sun! To make it a great experience all summer long,here are a few essential

guidelines!

- No Lifeguard on Duty! Anyone 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older.
- No glass containers!! If even one breaks, the pool must be drained! Very Expensive!
- · No alcoholic beverages! Alcohol and bodies of water do not go together!

- not for recreational use! Please use it only if there is an emergency!

GOTTA LOVE THOSE PETS!




