Requirements:

Newborn Exam must include:

Heart rate, reflexes (Babinski, stepping, Moro, planter, palmer, rooting reflex), APGAR at 1 and 5 minutes, muscle tone, color, weight, temperature, length, chest and head circumference, head moldings, caput, fontanelles, complete palate, tongue tie, lip tie, general appearance, eye reactivity, ear placement, clavicle, extremities, chest retractions, nasal flaring, lung sounds, respirations, hip dysplasia, abdomen, bowel sounds, genitals, anus, spine, and hearing.
