 - Balance is at \$99,865

- AD Report:
 - President's Bowl was a success; lots of compliments about WHS students and how they conducted themselves
 - Weather & AD roles: Nate gets reports from National Weather Service throughout the day; a lot of collaboration goes on b/w ADs & National Weather Service; use apps to track lightning (30 minute delay if hear thunder or see lightning or if lightning on app); for winter activities, ADs look at travel conditions
 - Hard to make up canceled games; try to set make-up dates, but it doesn't always happen
 - COVID: some schools we play at may have mask requirements; when WHS travels to those schools, have to wear masks; AD will send message to coaches, parents, and team about COVID mandates at schools for away games
