## Presentation by Al Bergen

Mr. Bergen presented a suggestion that if the ditch on Main Street from 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue to the cemetery, on the west side, could be contoured to ditch standards with dirt brought in "to level it out" to the right proportions that it would more appealing, and would be easier to mow in the summer.

Mr. Bergen also suggested that the board should be consistent in the emergency signs project, via Motion, to appoint an individual to gather quotes. Mr. Bergen was told that Mr. Jorgensen had volunteered to get the quotes for the project.

#### **Community Center Update:**

- Mr. Madden gave an outline of projects that needed to be completed such as countertop installation, plumbing hook ups, and chair rail installation.
- Mr. Madden is pricing out the chairs and tables this week. He has also received a quote from Zaks as to the deck and siding, which will be done one the weather dries the grounds. Quote came in around the \$13,000 mark for the deck and siding.
- Work on the landscape and outside projects will proceed as the weather permits.

#### **Highlights from the RM Meeting**

• The RM has voted to extend the landfill at the cost of \$450,000. The project is at the permit stage all the qualifications, have thus far been completed and waiting on the province for verification.

- New subdivisions are on the go at Hague and Laird.
- Policy on employee benefit package is being done.
- The RM Foreman is working on the culverts in the Hamlet to keep them open for the water to freeze but the "hotsie" that is used broke down so they will be renting one to proceed.
- Revenue sharing for the hamlet is up for 2017.
- Population in the 2016 Census was up to 522.

## **Roads**

Consensus of the board members was that Sunrise, Maple, and Country roads would receive the SB90 as well as the loop at the post office on 1st Avenue and a portion of Pembroke Road.

MOTION: That we contract Sands Dust Control to do Maple Drive, Country Lane & Sunrise Drive as well as the remainder of product to complete the loop at the mailboxes and a portion of Pembroke Road for a total value of \$80,000.
