## **Proposal for elevating and re-leveling playground equipment at Heritage Drive Park:**

**Problem:** When the concrete footings were poured for both the play structure and the swings, they were poured approximately 12" too low. The result of this is that the swings, the bottom of the slide, the fireman's pole and all of the ladders end well below grade. By the time we pull enough sand away for the playground features to be used, we are left with a deep hole with a muddy bottom that tends to stay wet.

The other problem is that the concrete piles seem to be settling and or sinking. The original installer was out once to re-level the play structure, but it already needs to be done again.

**Proposal:** The first order of business will be to lift the play equipment to the proper height. I propose a set of steel spacers manufactured to the correct length (approximately 12"). A total of 6 spacers are required for the swing set and 12 are required for the play structure. The swing set is on higher ground and seems to be staying level so just simple spacers should be sufficient there. The play structure however seems to be settling. (possibly due to the concrete pilings being poured into a hole that was partially filled with rain water) For these spacers, I propose manufacturing (2) spacers at a fixed length to anchor the structure, and the rest would be adjustable (telescoping in ½" increments) in case the pilings continue to settle and or sink. This way, re-leveling could be done simply by shoveling a bit of sand aside and adjusting the length of the spacer. See quote for details and pricing.

**Quotation for raising and re-leveling play structure and swing set at Heritage Drive Park in Neuanlage:**

**Materials:**

-36 pcs metal profiles ¼" thick, 8" diameter complete with bolt pattern to match existing playground equipment. (36) X \$13.20 = \$475.20

-24' of 4-1/2" X 3/16 wall mechanical tubing \$252.65

-24' of 4-1/8 X 3/16 wall mechanical tubing \$229.42

-(54) 3/8" concrete anchors \$66.29

-(54 sets) bolt, self-locking nut, two washers for feet of playground \$23.45

-(10 sets) adjustment bolt, self-locking nut. Two washers for adjustable spacers \$16.28

-paint \$35

**Total materials: \$1098.29**

**Labor:**

Saw material, drill holes, weld, debur and paint spacers: \$950

Dig away sand, install spacers, level and raise play structure and swing set, re-level sand in both areas: \$1500

**Total labor: \$2450**

**Total cost: \$3548.29**

If council decides to proceed, I would need 3-4 weeks to complete this work and the play structures would be out of commission for 1-2 days while the final installation is being done.
