ANNOUNCEMENT TO CUSTOMERS: CHANGE OF SERVICE

Attn: Residents

Effective Sept to May pickup will be changed to Saturdays at 9am. **The last Wednesday pickup will be Sept 8th – The First Saturday pickup will be Sept 11th.**

Please note this is what is being enforced by the RM at the dump. All loads are being inspected at the gate. Please see changes below.

Just a few guidelines on what can be Recycled and what can be garbage.

- Recyclables **must** be in a clear plastic bag supplied by the Hamlet (Available at the rink).
- What can be recycled – Pop bottles, cans, beverage containers, newspapers, plastics, paper/cardboard, tin cans, and glass bottles. **No aerosol cans, electronics, compost, or glass jars.**
- Remove caps from milk jugs and beverage containers, **give them a quick rinse and flatten.**
- Have a look at the bottom of your plastic containers. If there is a number between 1 and 7 it is recyclable.
- **Not Accepted:** Waxed cardboard, cardboard polycoat containers, food-contaminated pizza or oil soiled boxes
- **Not Accepted:** Polycoat cups and containers (coffee cups, soup), laminated paper, soiled or food-contaminated paper plates, etc.
- **Not Accepted:** Black/near black coloured plastics, Styrofoam, plastic stretch film/wrap, plastics, small plastics (4x6cm) bottle caps, agricultural chemical containers, etc.
- **All cardboard** must be flattened and then either bagged in clear plastic, stretch wrapped in a bundle, or taped in a bundle. **Any cardboard that is not flattened or bundled will not be accepted.**
- **Maximum size of cardboard is 24" x 36" (because of recycle bin size) If larger please cut to this size.**
- All garbage must be in **tyed bags** of reasonable size and weight. (If bags are overfilled they tear when being picked up, it will be the responsibility of the home owner to clean this up.
- Max weight of bags is 25lbs. Overweight bags will not be picked up.
- **Maximum number of bags per house hold is 5 (Recyclables and garbage combined)**
- Garbage will not be picked up if thrown loosely in a bin.
- No Construction material, scrap metal, tires, concrete, sofas, mattress, **grass clippings, tree trimmings, garden refuse, or straw**, will be picked up.
- **Compost is not recyclable or Garbage;** please consider using a compost bin, to reduce waste.
- There are lots of items that can be recycled, however, cannot be processed by us. Divert these items to other recycling facilities! The Saskatchewan Waste Reduction Council (SWRC) site has a search engine so you can look up information on divertible waste materials.
