

NOTICE TO PUBLIC

ALL members of gallery must follow Bylaw 9.2023 Council Meeting Procedures conduct of Section 34 attached:

34 Conduct of Public

34.1 All persons in the public gallery at a council meeting shall:

- (a) refrain from addressing council or a member unless expressly permitted to do so;
- (b) refrain from carrying on discussions or otherwise communicating with others within the gallery;
- (c) refrain from disturbing the proceedings by words, gestures or actions including applauding, displaying flags, placards or similar material;
- (d) refrain from using cellular telephones or other electronic devices at any time within council chambers;
- (e) refrain from making audio or video recordings of council proceedings;
- (f) refrain from entering a council meeting except prior to commencement of the meeting and during breaks in proceedings. For clarity, members of the public may leave the meeting at any time, but must proceed to the waiting area or leave the building, shall not leave behind any belongings, and may not return to the meeting until there is a break in proceedings. Any belongings left behind may be subject to removal at the discretion of council.
