Food Pantry

February Greetings from the Food Pantry.

We have started the New Year as expected, with procedures that have been tested and found satisfactory during 2021. We still miss the direct contact with clients picking their own food preferences and having a chance for all of the volunteers to meet the families we serve. The increased numbers of people with Covid has had a greater impact on the pantry this year so far than it did last year.

Some of the clients announce they have tested positive when they show up in the pantry parking lot, but they say they cannot isolate from eating so they come to get food from the pantry rather than going to a grocery store. Yes it is unnerving for the people who actually interact with these particular families but we take the information with as little actual contact as possible, with all of the contact being outside the pantry. So far none of the volunteers who have had contact with infected clients have contracted Covid. All of the volunteers are required to be vaccinated and wear masks, and social distancing is also practiced as much as possible. The pantry provides masks and gloves and disinfectant as needed.

That is not to say no volunteers have contracted Covid. We had as many as 5 volunteers in isolation at a time after the holidays. None of them were people who had direct contact with clients. So several of us have had to shift to tasks that were not their standard jobs, but so far we have been able to handle distribution days without problems.

Food and funding continues to come to the pantry generously. We still get weekly food deliveries from Feeding America and monthly deliveries from the State and our other pantry partners. There is no doubt that God's hand is involved in this pantry.

December showed a slight increase in the number of families using the pantry. I have heard from some of our regular clients that they have been able to find employment and currently don't need to come to the pantry now. I am always happy to get this news.

There are many other formerly regular clients, who were totally disabled, whom we have not seen for quite a while. We don't know for sure what has happened to them. It is an opportunity to do some social networking when we can.
